# **A.** Prophet for Moses (6:26-7:2)

- 1. God's Commission (vv. 26-29)
  - a. What is the function of Aaron's genealogy that Moses has just finished?
  - b. How is Israel to leave Egypt?

## 2. Moses' Objection (v. 30)

- a. why should we not assume this is simply a summary of Moses' old objections?
- b. Why is it possible Moses is again complaining about God's calling?
- c. How has Moses failed to grasp the nature of his role?

#### 3. God's Patience (vv. 1-2):

- a. How does God display his patience toward Moses?
- b. How does God's patience toward Moses put Pharaoh 'in his place,' and how is this a direct challenge to Pharaoh?

4. **Application**: What are ways we make excuses regarding God's commands?

## **B.** Education for Egypt (7:3-7)

- 1. Pharaoh's Hard Heart (vv. 3-4)
  - a. Why is Moses' eloquence (or lack) irrelevant?
    - 1) Why will Pharaoh move from being simply unwilling to obey to incapable of obeying Moses' commands?
    - 2) What does Pharaoh's stubborn cruelty prove to Israel? Why was it necessary for God to harden Pharaoh's heart?
    - 3) How is Pharaoh's hard heart in keeping with God's sovereign plan?
  - b. Is God unjust to harden Pharaoh's heart?
    - 1) Where else does this word *hard* appear, and how is it used?
    - 2) How did God harden Pharaoh's heart? What did God *not* do to Pharaoh?
    - 3) Why did God not make Israel's redemption a quick and tidy affair?

- c. <u>Application</u>: what has God actually entrusted Moses with, and why is it a blessing to be entrusted only with that and nothing more?
- d. <u>Application</u>: How has Moses shown he's been operating under a worldly standard of success and ministry?
- 2. Evangelism in Egypt (v. 5)
  - a. What is one of the purposes of the plagues?
  - b. What will Israel know (6:7) and what will Egypt know (7:5) because of what God does?
  - c. <u>Application</u>: in what sense are the plagues evangelical? Are they effective?
  - d. **Application**: How does God's word have a dual purpose?
  - e. <u>Application</u>: what is the biggest problem in your world today? How do our activities reflect what we think our biggest problem is?
- 3. Egypt's Teachers (vv. 6-7)
  - a. What is Moses celebrating here?
  - b. **Application**: why is it important to take note of spiritual victories in our own lives?

- c. More than 'you're never too old to do ministry,' what is the significance of the ages of Moses and Aaron? What is God showing us?
- d. How are we qualified to come to the Lord's Table?
