OBJECTIVES

Rider and Horse demonstrate a willing harmonic partnership.

The Horse performs only at a walk and jog. The Rider should exhibit correct basic position, basic aids and an understanding of the figures with correct bend onr corners & circles The Horse should be compliant, show a level of relaxation and exhibit an understanding of the rider's aids.

The Jog should be a natural gait within the horse's ability and should exhibit a swinging back and can be ridden Sitting or Rising but not a combination of both. REQUIREMENTS

Working Walk Free Walk Working Jog 20m circles at a working jog Serpentine – 3 equal loops at working jog (each loop to be half 20m circle) ENTRY NO:
