

C: We come into your house with the noise and cares of the world bearing down on us. We expect you fix it or to make it go away. Instead, you offer space for us to repent, refresh, and restore. Forgive us our short-sightedness. Forgive us our selfishness. For us our impatience. Show us how to enter your house with gratitude and praise.

P: Our God receives our pleas with open ears and a forgiving heart. Receive now the entire forgiveness of all your sins, and be washed with the cleansing sound of God's grace. In Jesus' name we pray.


C: Amen.

# \* Borning Cry

"I was there to hear your borning cry, I'll be there when you are old. I rejoiced the day you were baptized to see your life unfold. I was there when you were but a child, with a faith to suit you well; in a blaze of light you wandered off to find where demons dwell."

# \* Borning Cry

"When you heard the wonder of the Word I was there to cheer you on; you were raised to praise the living Lord, to whom you now belong. If you find someone to share your time and you join your hearts as one, I'll be there to make your verses rhyme from dusk till rising sun."

P: In Holy Baptism our gracious heavenly Father liberates us from sin and death by joining us to the death and resurrection of our Lord Jesus Christ. We are born children of a fallen humanity; in the waters of Baptism we are reborn children of God and inheritors of eternal life. By water and the Holy Spirit, we are made members of the Church which is the body of Christ.

P: As we live with him and with his people, we grow in faith, love, and obedience to the will of God.

## **Sponsors and Parents:**

We present *Elena Marie Rodriguez and lan Humberto Rodriguez* to receive the Sacrament of Holy Baptism.

The minister addresses the sponsors and guardians.

P: In Christian love you have presented Elena and Ian for Holy Baptism. You should, therefore, faithfully bring them to the services of God's house, and teach them the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and the Ten Commandments.

P: As they grow in years, you should place in their hands the Holy Scriptures and provide for their instruction in the Christian faith, that, living in the covenant of their Baptism and in communion with the Church, they may lead godly lives until the day of Jesus Christ.

- P: Do you promise to fulfill these obligations?
- **Sponsors and Parents: We do.**
- P: Congregation of Trinity Lutheran Church, do you promise to assist these sponsors and parents to fulfill these obligations?
- C: We do and we ask God to help and guide us.

- HOLY BAPTISM THANKSGIVING
- P: The Lord be with you.
- C: And also with you.
- P: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.
- C: It is right to give him thanks and praise.
- Water is poured into the Baptismal Font as the prayer is said.
- P: Holy God, mighty Lord, gracious Father: We give you thanks, for in the beginning your Spirit moved over the waters and you created heaven and earth.

P: By the gift of water, you nourish and sustain us and all living things. By the waters of the flood you condemned the wicked and saved those whom you had chosen, Noah and his family. You led Israel by the pillar of cloud and fire through the sea, out of slavery into the freedom of the promised land.

P: In the waters of the Jordan your Son was baptized by John and anointed with the Spirit. By the baptism of his own death and resurrection your beloved Son has set us free from the bondage to sin and death, and has opened the way to the joy and freedom of everlasting life. He made water a sign of the kingdom and of cleansing and rebirth.

P: In obedience to his command, we make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

Pour out your Holy Spirit, so that *Elena Marie Rodriguez* and *Ian Humberto Rodriguez* who are about to be here baptized may be given new life.

P: Wash away their sins, cleans them by this water, and bring them forth as heirs of your glorious kingdom. To you be given praise and honor and worship through your Son, Jesus Christ our Lord, in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever.

#### C: Amen

The minister addresses the baptismal group and the congregation.

P: I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church, the faith in which we baptize. Do you renounce all the forces of evil, the devil, and all his empty promises?

C: I do.

- P: Do you believe in God the Father?
- C: I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

- P: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, the Son of God?
- C: I believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. He was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the virgin Mary. He suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. He descended into hell.\*

<sup>\*</sup>Or, He descended to the dead.

C: On the third day he rose again. He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again to judge the living and the dead.

- P: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit?
- C: I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen

## The minister baptizes each child.

- P: Elena Marie Rodriguez, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- P: <u>lan Humberto Rodriguez</u>, I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

P: The Lord be with you.

C: And also with you.

The minister lays both hands on the head of each of the baptized and prays for the Holy Spirit:

P: God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, we give you thanks for freeing your sons and daughters from the power of sin and for raising them up to a new life through this holy sacrament.

P: Pour your Holy Spirit upon <u>Elena and</u> <u>lan</u>: the spirit of wisdom and understanding, the spirit of counsel and might, the spirit of knowledge and the fear of the Lord, the spirit of joy in your presence.

C: Amen

P: <u>Elena Marie Rodriguez</u>, child of God, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ forever.

C: Amen

P: <u>Ian Humberto Rodriguez</u>, child of God, you have been sealed by the Holy Spirit and marked with the cross of Christ forever.

C: Amen

A lighted candle is given to the baptized (to the sponsor of a young child) by a representative of the congregation who says:

- R: Elena, let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.
- R: Ian, let your light so shine before others that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

P: O God, the giver of all life, look with kindness upon Humberto and Jennifer. Let them ever rejoice in the gifts you have given them. Make them teachers and examples of righteousness for Elena and Ian.

P: Strengthen them in their own Baptism so they may share eternally with Elena and Ian, the salvation you have given them, through Jesus Christ our Lord.

C: Amen.

#### \* WELCOME

The ministers and the baptismal group turn toward the congregation; a representative of the congregation says:

P: Through Baptism God has made Elena and lan our new siblings in Christ and fellow members of the priesthood we all share in Christ Jesus, that together we may proclaim the praise of God and bear his creative and redeeming Word to all the world.

#### \* WELCOME

C: We welcome you into the Lord's family. We receive you as fellow members of the body of Christ, children of the same heavenly Father, and workers with us in the kingdom of God.

Applause is appropriate as the pastor presents the newly Baptized to the congregation. All return to their places.
