

## **Spartan Station OTC MEDICATION RELEASE**

We have the following items available for use, if and when necessary. If there are ANY of these items you do NOT want us to use on your child, please circle and initial the items and notify a staff member. Only staff members are allowed to administer any and all medications. The brands used may vary from store brands to name brands but are basically the same contents. If your child needs **any** of the items listed on a consistent basis, you are required to supply the needed items.

- Antibiotic/pain relief ointment
- 1.0% Hydrocortisone anti-itch cream for children
- Aloe Vera Burn Relief Gel
- Lotion for dry skin
- Baby Lotion
- Baby Powder – with or without cornstarch
- Diaper Rash Ointment
- Baby pain relief gel for teething
- Band-Aids – **\*please let us know if your child is allergic to Latex\***

I give the Spartan Station Staff permission to administer the previous OTC preparations, if needed, to my child.

***Parent's of Infants (0-2 years) are required to bring their own pain medications.***

A parent will always be called to verify dosage and permission to administer the following:

- Children's Liquid Ibuprofen for ages 2-11 – 100 mg per 1 teaspoon
- Children's chewable or melt-away Pain Reliever (80mg) –acetaminophen- for ages 2 – 11

I give the Spartan Station Staff permission to administer the OTC medications listed above only if contacted by phone. I have read and understand the Medication Policy located in the Spartan Station Parent Handbook.
