March Workshop: **THE COLOR OF LIGHT**

Focusing on color and light, Sally discusses optical mixing of layered color and how to truly see and identify color, especially subtle color. The effects of light on color, composition, and perception, as well as the use of different types of light are explored. Each student receives individual attention and critiques. Demonstrations, lectures, and a slide show are designed to give students tools to achieve intensely beautiful color.

Over 500 of her paintings are in private collections. She is a signature member of the American Impressionist Society and member of Portrait Society of America, California Art Club and Oil Painters of America.

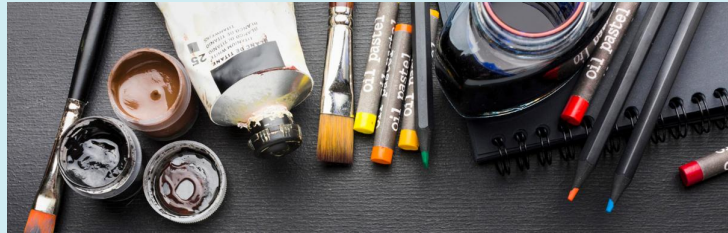
