#### **IASS News**

The first half of 2014 has been an exciting and rewarding time for the International Academy of Social Sciences (IASS). Several noteworthy events and changes include the following: full transition of the Guild of International Scholars and associated journals into a full fledge learned society, the creation of the rank of Academician of Social Sciences as the highest rank granted by the Academy, the appointment of several prominent community leaders and scholars as Academicians of Social Sciences, and keynote speeches delivered by several members of IASS in Thailand

### Insignia of the International Academy of Social Sciences

The Guild of Independent Scholars was established in 2008 to serve as the steering committee to oversee the Journal of Alternative Perspectives in the Social Sciences. Due to the success of the Journal and massive expansion of the membership its duties were expanded and its structure started to reflect traditional learned societies. The Editorial and Advisory boards were expanded over the years to reflect a more diverse membership and to represent a larger variety of disciplinary areas. Early this year the decision was made to change the name of the Guild of Independent Scholars into the International Academy of Social Sciences (IASS) and transform the organization into a more traditional learned society. In order to reflect the changes in function, the governing

structure of the organization changed to one emulating traditional Orders of Knighthood and European Confraternities. Dr. Otto F. von Feigenblatt, Count of Kobryn was chosen to serve as the Academy's first chairman with the title of Grandmaster of the International Academy of Social Sciences. Dr. von Feigenblatt's pivotal in the establishment subsequent success of the Journal of Alternative Perspectives in the Social Science were taken into consideration making this important very appointment. The structure maintains the Editorial and Advisory Boards with important supervisory and advisory functions.



### The Ceremonies

Two solemn investiture ceremonies were held in Bangkok, Thailand during the months of July and August. One event was held at Assumption Suksa School and a second con at Wat Vorajanyawas.
