#### Program Notes - American Riversongs

American Riversongs is based on traditional and composed music of an earlier time, when the rivers and waterways were the littelines of a growing nation.

American Riversongs begins with a rousing setting of 'Down the River', followed by an expansive and dramatic treatment of 'Shenandoah' or 'Across the Wilde Missouri,' as it is sometimes called. After a brief transition, a brass band is heard playing a quadrille-like version of Stephen Foster's <u>'The Glendy</u> <u>Burk</u>' As the 'Glendy Burk' travels along, a second theme. Is introduced by piccolo, flutes and tarbourine. The second theme is based on a Creole barboula tune that probably originated in the Louislana delta region. Other composers have used this melody, including Louis Moreau Gattschak in his <u>La Barboula</u>. <u>On 2</u> for plano and his Symphony no. 1, subtitled <u>A Night in the Tropics</u>. The barboula theme. Is marked by an incessant syncopated ragime rhydmm and used to good effect in the cools to bring American Riversongs to a roway, too-storping close.
