## Who are you?

Someone asked me the other day, "How do you identify yourself today?" I replied, "I am an old white fat man!" Well, that was a silly answer to a serious question. Our identity is extremely important. Just ask those who are trying hard to steal your identity. We need to know that Satan and his kind are liars and want to steal our identity so we can be used for their purpose. We need to listen to someone who will tell the truth because the truth will set us free.

Just ask God. He tells us who we are in His word. Ephesians 2 reveals that without Christ we are dead in our trespasses and sins. We are alienated from God without hope in the world. 1 Peter 2:9-10 communicates clearly who we are if we are in Christ. It tells us five important facts about our life in Christ.

In Christ we are chosen instead of rejected. We are God's chosen race. Not those of some ethnic heritage but those who cooperate with God's plan. God made a choice before anything became everything Eph. 1:4. The Creator knew the bad choices we would make in our brokenness, but He decided to repair the broken before they were broken. God decided that Jesus would repair us with His work. It is a gift. It is not achieved. It must be received. John 1:12-13. The lie is that we are rejected by God. God's word says He made a choice before anyone did anything good or bad. God gave His Son. That was His choice. My choice was to trust in the Gift God gave. God said He made me one of His chosen because of His choice combined with my choice.

In Christ we are valuable instead of worthless. God says His nation is made up of folks who are holy and His. The value of something is determined by who owns it and how much the owner is willing to pay. Think about the difference between how much one of your old bibles is worth compared to the value of a bible owned by Abraham Lincoln. How much is a gallon of gas worth if you are on the way to save a life of someone dear to you? A person who is in Christ belongs to God. We are "His own possession". How much was God willing to pay so we could call Him Abba Father? Look to the cross to see your value to our Heavenly Father. See Philippians 2 to discover how much God values us.

In Christ we are loved instead of hated. Once I was a nobody. Now God has made me a somebody because He loves me. God is not ashamed of me. Hebrews 2:11, Jere. 31:3. The lie says God loves you only when you are good. God says His love is unconditional, and it is unending. God is not fickle. God never changes and He is never going to stop loving you or me. Why is His love eternal? Because God is love and He is eternal. Ps 100:5.

In Christ we are forgiven instead of guilty. The lie says there is no mercy. God says His children have received mercy. God is never surprised by sin. He totally forgave us. Romans 8:1. Hebrews 12 tells us that God disciplines us but never punishes us for our sin. God is naturally forgiving Is. 43. Jesus paid for all sin. Eph 1:7

In Christ we are able instead of useless. 1 Peter 2:9. In Christ each person is a royal priest. Every member is a person who represents God to humans and humans to God. We are fully capable of representing God. God has a calling for you. A purpose for you. A job for you. A role for you. God says He gives you power fulfill your purpose. 2 Cor 3:5-6. The lie says we are useless to God. God says I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me Philippians 4:13.

How to stop the lies? BELIEVE GOD! His word, His Spirit, and His people.

Here is your identity. When you trusted Christ, you became one of His family. You became part of His Church. He says you are freely chosen, you are priceless, you are amazingly loved, you are absolutely forgiven, and you are completely capable of growing into the likeness of Christ. You are entirely capable of fighting the good fight of the faith. You are absolutely capable of making a difference in the world where you can share the excellencies of Him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.
