Composition of the Man Species: Spirit, Soul, and Body?

Joh 4:24 God *is* a Spirit: and they that worship him must worship *him* in spirit and in truth (*in other words God is the Spirit of spirits, and He is God in authority over spirits. In addition He has declared there is none other spirit with authority above Him. Study Isaiah Chapters 40 through 45.*

And so anything, or anyone, anybody declares in the place of God is conducting idol and/ or false God worship.

Even the atheist and those promoting or holding to "evolution" are conducting, "idol/ image (imaginings)" and "false god worship", because they are declaring something in His place; wishing for His none existence, which is abomination).

- Rom 2:29 But he (*the redeemed of Jesus Christ*) *is* a Jew, which is one inwardly; and circumcision *is that* of the heart, in the spirit, *and* not in the letter (*or trust in ones ability and strength to do the written law*); whose praise *is* not of men, but of God.
- 1Co 2:11 For what man knoweth the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knoweth no man, but the Spirit of God (In other words; no matter how much we may learn of GOD, there will always be much we must accept by "FAITH").
- Heb 4:12 For the word of God *is* quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and *is* a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart (*or spirit*).
- 1Pe 3:4 But *let it be* the hidden man of the heart (*which is the spirit*), in that which is not corruptible, *even the ornament* of a meek and quiet spirit, which is in the sight of God of great price (*When we study 1Peter 3:1 through 3:4 we see that Peter is explaining how to win a spouse (or anyone else) over to God and the Lord Jesus Christ. If the person will not hear the convincing words of scripture, then let it be done by "the hidden man of the heart" which is the spirit).*

My Observations: <u>Explained/ written to the best of my perception</u>, of, "Searching out Things of God".

Spirit is –

The non-decaying essence of a being's given by the life of God.
