Notes for Parents & Guardians



Catering: All families are requested to bring fruit or other suitable food for shared morning/afternoon teas. Clubs/parents will be allocated a break to assist with food preparation and delivery to all groups and instructors. All riders should have a clearly labelled water bottle to keep in their group's crate which will be available and filled for each break time.

Stay tuned for information about a possible dinner hosted by Dalby PC. The kitchen, bbq and coldroom facilities will be available for people/clubs to store and prepare meals.

Supervision: although this event is a camp, all riders require a nominated parent or guardian to be present for the duration of their child's attendance at camp.

Sleeping arrangements: are to be organized by parents or guardians – powered campsites are available on the showgrounds at no extra charge. Camping and yards are unallocated and are provided on a 'first-in-first-served' basis.

Learning experiences: parents and guardians will be able to learn along with their riders at all of our information sessions. We will have expert advice on hand to answer questions and give practical information to help both horse and rider.

To make this event a success we need the support and help from as many parents or guardians as possible. Some jobs include: setup and pack up of gear for various disciplines, rail stewards, group supervisors and helpers, etc, etc. We will especially need help to pack up on Sunday afternoon!

Each rider will be put into a small group of comparable ability and they will remain with this group for the duration of camp. To help us to put your rider in an appropriate group, please send information about your rider and horse's ability to your Club secretary to fill out the accompanying Excel spreadsheet with as much detail as possible. All payments are to be made to your Club secretary.

2017 Schedule of Fees

We have kept the camp costs the same as in 2016 despite a change in venue and significantly increased ground hire, there are also no camping/stabling costs. We hope that you still see the value for money the camp provides and continue to support us 😊

\$225 per rider – 4 x full day instruction **only**

\$120 per beginner rider – 4 x ½ day instruction (max 8 in this group)
