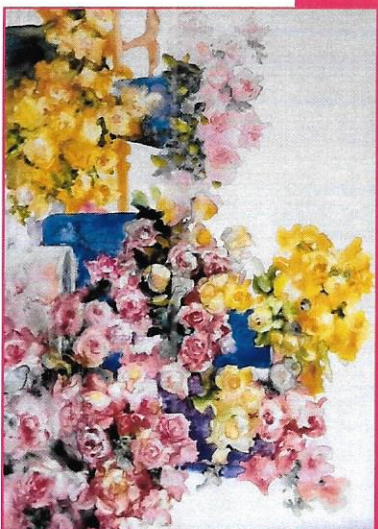

A practicing artist and teacher, for more than thirty five years, Paula's talent and style encompasses techniques ranging from naturalistic to abstract expressionism. Paula's painting's contain vibrant colors, expressive movement, and creative energy. "Ethereal" has described her porcelains in the last few years.

A native of Roswell, New Mexico, Paula began painting with oils and acrylics in the early "70's," then, moving onto the exploration of delicate porcelain art and, presently, adding pastels, acrylics, and palette knife oils to her art forms. Paula is a certified teacher of the International Porcelain Artists and Teachers, Inc., Member of the Professional Porcelain Artists Association. She is a member of the Roswell (NM) Fine Art League and New Mexico Miniature Art Society. A member of the World Organization of China Painters, and the Oklahoma Art Guild. Paula studied art at Eastern New Mexico University community classes, workshops, and art schools under practicing, renowned artists throughout the United States.

Paula has taught various aspects of art in several mediums in schools and in community education. Paula is also teaching workshops on *Color and Design*, in all media.

She has taught numerous workshops and seminars since 1976, including Carrizo Lodge Art School (NM), Louisiana Porcelain Art Schools, PPAA schools, PAGN School of Porcelain Art, Upper Midwest Porcelain Art School, Seaside Porcelain Art School, World Organization of China Painters Museum, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma.

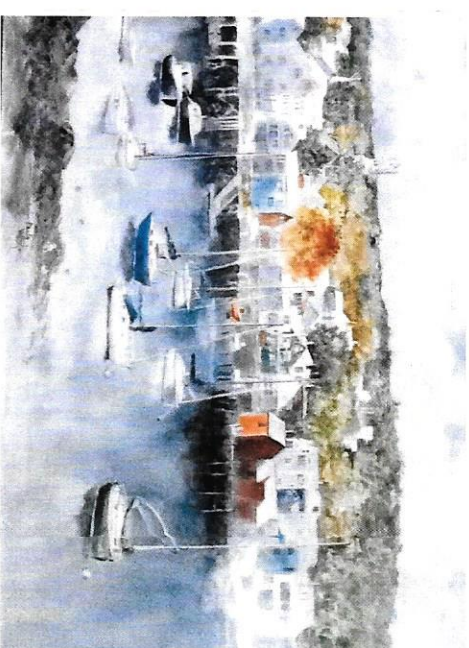
Her business experience has been multifaceted, including art director of Carrizo Lodge Art School (NM), producer of seven of her own art instructional videos.; the most recent video on painting water, and a contemporary design and composition book for the porcelain artist. She is the author of "*The Essence of Lustre in Porcelain Art*," (1980) and numerous articles and booklets for many professional artists' magazines. Paula was featured in the book, "*Porcelain Art-The International Collector*" that was published in Australia. This book presents thirty artist from 24 countries, but only includes five from the US. on a book for those artist wanting more information She is presently working on a book about landscapes. She founded the Paula White Home Study School of Art and *The Grapevine Quarterly*, an art educational newsletter with articles by Paula and guest artists, in 1998,

Paula has won many awards in national art shows. Her works are in many private collections in the U.S. and abroad. She is often commissioned to create special works of art, on porcelain, tile, and canvas.

At this time, many of her artistic endeavors are on display at her home studio in Oklahoma City. Call for an appointment to view or purchase her art.

Paula feels art is an expression of the inner self and that this inner creativity is God-given. "I strive to capture my impression of God's beauty on any canvas whether porcelain, paper or canvas."

She feels painting on porcelain is a great challenge to mind, hand, and spirit; as it is much more exacting and multifaceted than other mediums.

For further inspiration, Paula offers her extensive library--from books on art, artists, angels to music and history. There is much to inspire and nurture you.

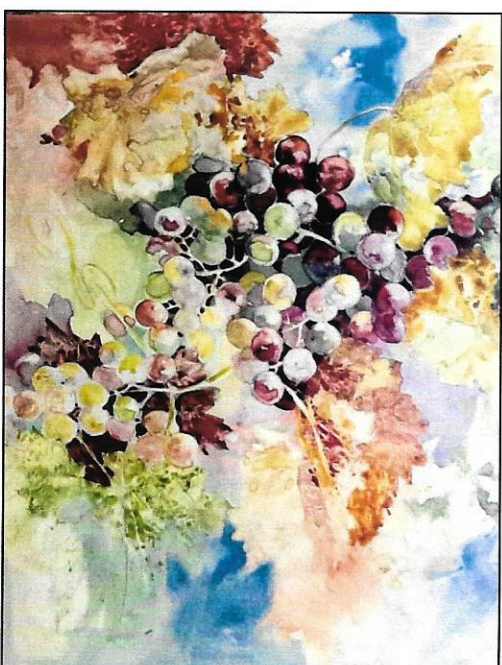
