Be Missionary Disciples /Parish Planning Update

Last week we received correspondence from Archbishop Lori outlining two important updates to the parish planning process:

First, in the next few weeks we will receive the results of our **Be Missionary Disciples** parish survey. Thank you who participating in that survey. Your Pastoral Staff and well as Pastoral Council will review and reflect on the survey results and address additional questions and disseminate additional parish-specific data. as Abp. Lori's pastoral letter, **A Light Brightly Visible**, noted missionary conversion *is for all the faithful*.

The second important update to our parish-level planning process is the formation of a **work group** to engage the process of pastoral conversion. We will include ALL OF YOU in that group and invite you, in this process- *so please consider this!*

A work group composed of clergy and AOB Central Services staff will be formed to develop recommendations for *cluster relationships* that will then be reviewed and modified by the Priest Council and by our work group over the next seven months. The resulting clusters will comprise the Archdiocesan Model for Planning and is expected to be completed by fall. The model will define both the cluster arrangements that will be the basis for planning as well as the specific planning work each parish or cluster of parishes to undertake.

We will begin our fiscal 2017 planning and budget process as usual which will be effective July 1, 2016. As we form our planning work group and disseminate survey data we need to be poised to review the cluster recommendations coming from the Archdiocesan work group due in the fall of 2016.

And in the words of Archbishop Lori: "May we, who are transformed by Jesus Christ through the power of the Holy Spirit, be emboldened to create the vision of a new life for the Church in the Archdiocese of Baltimore, and energized by the hope that it kindles in us!"
