POISONS



If you have any concerns that your dog may have ingested anyone of these, or others, please contact your veterinary practice asap. Always keep the bottle or label and take with you to the vets. Please do not leave these things to chance.

Xylitol

Xylitol is a sugar replacement often found in sugar-free products, peanut butter and chewing gum. Xylitol is extremely deadly.

Insecticides & Pesticides

Ingestion of these types of products, especially those that contain organophosphates can be life-threatening, even when ingested in small amounts.

Human Medication

Household common medications can be extremely harmful to any dog, causing ulcerated intestines, kidney failure, seizures, even death. Medication may include Antidepressants, Ibuprofen, Naproxen & Antihistamines.

Rat & Mouse Poison

Ingesting items such as these can cause internal bleeding, swelling of the brain, kidney failure, bloat, seizures, severe vomiting, even death.

Fertilizers

Some fertilizers **ARE** safe. Fertilizers that contain bone meal, blood meal, feather meal and iron can cause significant harm to your dog if ingested.

Household Cleaners-detergents & Sprays

Some household cleaners pose a severe risk to our dogs due to their corrosive nature. Products can include toilet cleaner, drainage cleaner, rust lime & calcium removers and bleach. Cleaning products stated to be natural can cause severe reactions.
