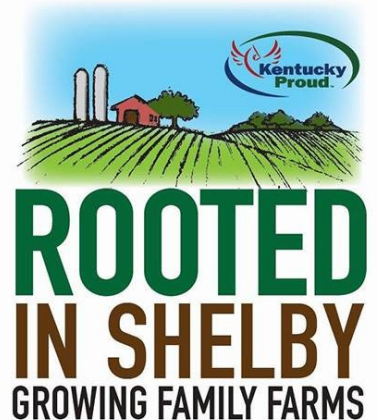

Thank You for your interest in our herd of goats. Please enjoy the brochure and if you have any questions please feel free to contact us. We want you happy with your experience and believe that the relationship between buyer and seller extends well beyond the point that the kid is picked up/delivered.

Whether you are looking for a nice milk goat to show or one whose job is to simply provide milk for your family we have what you need. Most of our percentage meat does are sold for herd replacements or embryo transfer recipient does. KY Proud tags are available for all Market animals at no additional charge, please let us know if you will need one.

Herd Health is a vital priority here at Keach Manor. All animals are tested for CAE bi-annually, pre-ordered kids are pulled at birth and fed heat treated colostrum and pasteurized milk or quality goat commercial replacer. We have never had any abscesses and KY is a certified TB and Brucellosis free state. The health and happiness of the animals is number one. We routinely vaccinate for CDT, Pneumonia, Bo-Se & Lysigen. Animals have year round access to pastures, free choice local hay, a local custom grain mix and free choice minerals (Bi-carb mix, DE, Kelp & Salt).

A non-refundable deposit of \$100 is required to hold your place on a 2021 kid. Please pick a first and second choice.

We do NOT reserve the right to retain a kid that is born. That means if the kid is born, it is yours.

NO DEPOSIT WILL BE RETURNED IF THE BUYER CHANGES THEIR MIND.

Once a buyer commits to purchasing a kid(s) they are given 10 days for the deposit to arrive at Keach Manor.

If a deposit is not received on the 11th day, that reservation will open to another buyer.

Payment, Pick Up & Shipping: You will be notified via email/and or phone call when your kid is born. Kids must be paid in full within 10 days of notification or birth. Outside of the continuous United States buyers have 5 (FIVE) days to Pay in Full, to ensure all veterinary testing will be completed before shipping. Failure to do so forfeits the deposit and all monies paid and said kid is now available for sale to another party. **NOTE: If your kid is born and you pass on that kid you WILL lose your deposit!** You are more than welcome to make an appointment to pick up your kid at the farm. Kids must be picked up by 30 days of age or younger unless prior written arrangements have been made. Board, PER DAY, for kids not picked up by 31 days will accrue at \$5 per day. Shipping is available out of the following airports: Lexington or Louisville, KY. The buyer is responsible for arranging shipment with the airline, payment of all applicable fees to the airline and getting any necessary paperwork filed with the Department of Agriculture. A shipping crate can be sent to us or you can purchase one that we have for cost. Health certificate fee is \$50 which includes transport to and from the vet, health certificate and FREE transport to the airport. This fee does not include any additional testing for CAE, TB, and/or Brucellosis.

When purchasing young stock remember that there is no guarantee on the quality of what the mammary system might be when the goat freshens. We try very hard to make sure there are consistent udders in all of the lines, but there are no refunds if a kid does not turn out as a show prospect. If for some reason the doe or buck is unable to breed, please contact us so we can get a form for your vet to fill out explaining the problem. If the problem is genetic we will replace the goat with one of equal or better quality. We retain the right to purchase (at collection cost) 20 straws of semen from any buck kid sold*.

It truly takes a village to raise a child - or a baby goat! Any questions, concerns or problems please let us know.

Juli is yet another nice Liz daughter. We have been blessed with being able to own such a doe who consistently throws quality kids even when bred to different sires.

Juli was Grand Champion Junior Doe at the KY State Fair in 2013 so she stayed home the rest of the year, but came out and defended her title at the 2014 Kentucky State Fair (beating the 2014 ADGA Reserve Junior National Champion!)

Juli kidded and does she has a WOW mammary just like we expected! Typical of the L line of goats she is slow to mature but just like a fine wine, she was worth the wait. Juli was 2 x Reserve Grand Champion at the always competitive 2015 MO Quad Show, behind herdmate (now GCH) Keach Manor KHSD Nurse Betty 5*M. She easily finished up her last leg needed in 2016 showing in Illinois under ADGA Judge, Jay Bennett.

In 2016 Juli decided that Mr. Bond was just too irresistible, on her own. She kidded with 3 beautiful half Alpine/Saanen doe kids in 2017. And WOW, are they nice. Snack Pack was 3rd place Senior Dry Yearling & Youth Premier Junior Recorded Grade at the 2018 ADGA National Show (Reference)

Her yearling Saanen daughter, Jalapeno (deceased), was undefeated in her milking yearling classes.

Juli settled AI and was due to kid July 1st., 2018 She unfortunately developed Fescue Toxicity which caused the kids to die in utero (necropsy confirmed). She was bred again and kidded in 2019 just fine with a single buck kid who we have retained. She gave us mixed twins in 2020 that have both been retained.

Juli settled AI to *B des-Ruhigestelle Eclipse and is due in Feb. 1st buck & 1st doe are retained.

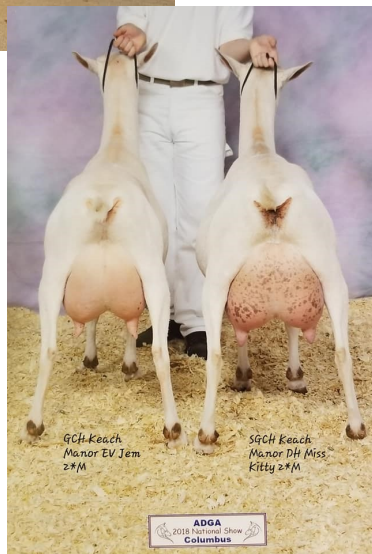

Our good ole gal Mascara, settled via AI to Stuck and then proceeded to kid with triplet does!

We parted with one doe to a show family in Alabama and retained the other two. We purchased Maysa back when the family had to relocate out of state. SGCH Maysa milked thru from her yearling year, earned 1 UR leg as a Yearling, another as a 2 yr old milk thru and her final leg as a 3 yr old. She awarded Reserve Grand Champion at the 2017 NAILE (middle photo).

Mehadi is a power packed gal (+AV V, 2- 89VEEE and Mohala (++V +, 2- 89VEEE) is more what is currently in style, tall, long and dairy. We like each of them and although they do not place highly as dry stock, but no worries they freshened impressively.

GCH Mehadi was 3 x Grand Champion as a first freshening 2 yr old (all 3 UR legs) in 2017. Deceased 2019, uterine tear.

Mohala thinks showing is for the birds and although she is just as beautiful as both of her sisters, she walks like a plow horse in the ring. Mohala will not be forced to go to any beauty pageants anytime soon. She did win the SG Lotto late in 2018.

Do we NEED 3 full littermate sisters? No, but not only are they correct and beautiful, so are their kids! Oh, did I mention that they milk too? All 3 girls have earned a permanent place in the barn.

These girls are also paternal half siblings to our Herd Queen, GCH Kickadee Hill WRS Look At Liz 6*M, all 4 are sired by SGCH +*B Willow Run Stormfront Stuck Up (a son of the infamous doe Snuggle).

Mohala & Maysa are milking thru from 2018 and continued without rebreeding into 2020. Have we mentioned how much we LOVE our girls that can provide milk 600+ days without rebreeding? =D

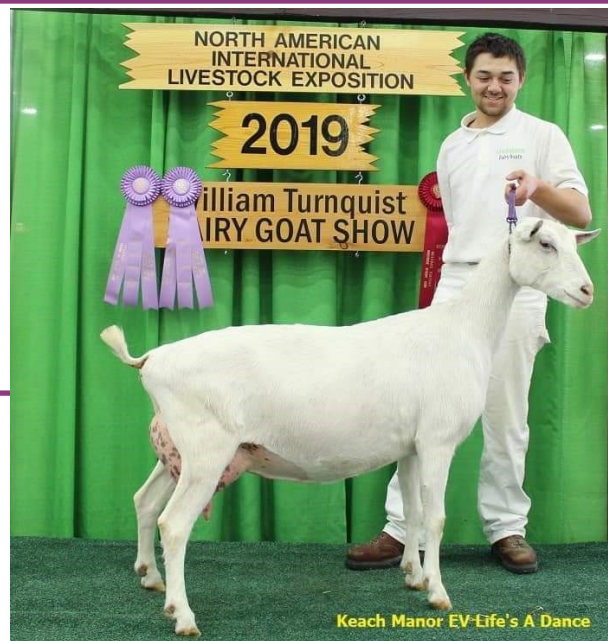

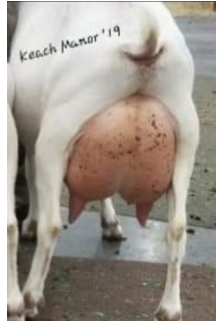

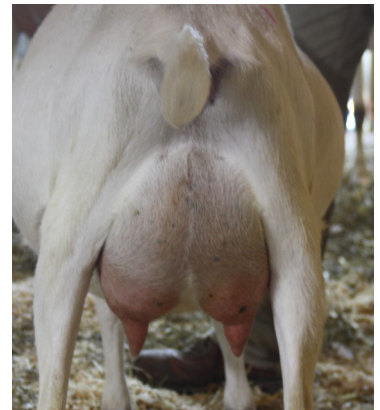
