Historically Black Colleges or Universities (HBCU)



- ❖ HBCUs existed for almost 200 years.
- ❖ At a time when African-Americans were unable to pursue an education at white institutions, HBCUs were created to educate African-Americans.
- ❖ There are currently 107 HBCU's in the United States.



HBCUs in the United States:

- Represent less than 3% of colleges & universities
- Enroll 12% of all African American students
- Produce 23% of all African American graduates
- Confer 40% of all STEM degrees
- 60% of all engineering degrees are earned by African American students



HBCUs Educate:

- 50% of African American teachers.
- 40% of African American health professionals.
- 70% of African American dentists and physicians.
- 58% of HBCUs offer students the opportunity to study abroad.



HBCUs Produce:

- 44% of all African American bachelor's degrees awarded for communications technology.
- 33% of all African American? bachelor's degrees awarded for engineering technology.
- 43% of all African American? bachelor's degrees awarded for mathematics.



- HBCUs have 1/8 of the average size of endowments than historically white colleges and universities.
- Against these odds, HBCUs historically have provided an affordable education to millions of students of color, graduating the majority of America's African American teachers, doctors, judges, engineers, and other scientific and technological professionals.






