

THE TAYLOR JACOBS SCHOLARSHIP

Important Notice:

Taylor Jacobs, Defense Department Systems Engineer, UD graduate & Founder of WaterRoots, a nonprofit organization she founded to expose children in underserved communities to free science, technology and engineering programs. **The Taylor Jacobs Scholarship** is for current college students who are pursuing an engineer degree.

Please make sure that you meet the eligibility requirements below before you complete and submit your application. You **must be currently enrolled as a full-time student at the University of Delaware or Delaware State University seeking an Engineering Degree** as an undergraduate or graduate student. You must identify as *African-American/Black or Hispanic* race. You must have a minimal GPA above a 2.3 cumulative average. You must attach a copy of your **college official transcript**. You must submit (2) **letters of recommendation**. You must submit **proof of enrollment**.

Applicants must submit a one-page, typed, double-spaced essay about a "Black engineer or inventor, write an essay on why you chose them and how you relate to their story." Essay must be typed in APA format with minimal errors. Completed application packets will include signed application, essay, letters of recommendations, enrollment verification and transcript.

Award amounts are between \$500-\$1000 per academic school year. **Awardees will receive a letter of acceptance by May 30.** Award amounts will be sent directly to university. All awards will be based on eligibility requirements met and funds available.
