

# Folkestone and Hythe Birds

Tetrad Guide: TR23 N

(Copt Point, Capel Battery and Folkestone Warren West)



## Introduction

The coastline is one of the main features within the tetrad TR23 N, over half of which is comprised by sea. In the southernmost part of the tetrad is Copt Point, with its low greensand and gault clay cliffs, and an extensive outcrop of rocks at low tide. To the north the coastline reverts to sand and there is a concrete sea defence known as the "apron". Inland is part of the Folkestone Warren SSSI, where landslips have given rise to a succession of steep, broken slopes where scrub and woodland has developed and there are several small ponds. The Warren is bounded by the high chalk cliffs and inland of these there is a small area of calcareous grassland and scrub, where Capel Battery was situated.

## Habitats and birds

It is known that bird collectors were active in Folkestone Warren in the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries though the details that support their records are not sufficient to allocate them to a specific tetrad.

Ticehurst (1909) mentions a Woodchat Shrike caught in a clump of brambles in the Warren in 1888 (the specimen is now in the Canterbury museum). He also notes a Great Grey Shrike in the Warren in 1893 and records that Folkestone Museum contained a White-fronted Goose, a Scaup and a Shore Lark that were obtained in the Warren.

On the 22<sup>nd</sup> September 1959 David Musson found the fourth county record of Yellow-browed Warbler in Folkestone Warren and also saw a Bluethroat there on the same day. Also in the 1950s John Perrot recorded 12 pairs of Nightingale breeding in the Warren.

In about 1980 Rob Lee (formerly Rob Hollingsworth) began watching the Copt Point area, being joined by Paul Howe from 1985, though both left the area in the late 1980s, Rob moving to Norfolk, and Paul to Thanet (though he later returned to live locally again). They began to systematically record movements at sea and diurnal overhead passage, as well as grounded migrants. A regular up-channel spring passage of Brent Geese, Common and Velvet Scoter and other wildfowl, waders including Bar-tailed Godwits, skuas including Pomarine, Little Gulls and the regular terns became evident, as well as autumn movements also involving Manx Shearwater and Black Tern.

In the winter months there were records of Bewick's Swan, Goldeneye, Goosander, Great Northern Diver and all three scarce grebes. Visual passage included swifts, hirundines, pipits, wagtails, finches (including Twite), buntings and some good counts of Tree Sparrow, whilst passerine migrants mainly comprised crests, warblers, thrushes (including Ring Ouzel), flycatchers and chats. Rarities included the first area record of Lesser Crested Tern, a Cory's Shearwater, a Roseate Tern, several Wrynecks and a couple of Icterine Warblers. A flock of Eider used to summer off Copt Point, with a peak of 34 there in June 1983.



Mediterranean Gulls became a regular feature at Copt Point from the late 1970s and it soon held the greatest concentrations in the country. From the early 1980s until his death in 2007 Raymond Henson recorded the gulls around Copt Point and his study of colour-ringed Mediterranean Gulls was published in the Kent Bird Report for 2001 and provided a very valuable insight into their movements and life histories. He also logged several Glaucous and Iceland Gulls.

A couple of pairs of Marsh Warblers bred between 1987 and 1991 (but there have been no sightings since) and Steve Broyd saw a Caspian Tern offshore on the 5<sup>th</sup> June 1988.

Dale Gibson and Ian Roberts watched Copt Point regularly from the late 1980s until about 2006, with less frequent visits since. A brick shelter and the adjacent undercliff below Wear Bay Road provide a good vantage point for seawatching (the shelter is in TR23 I but most seabird records have been included in TR23 N as they passed at a distance from the shore). A significant number of record area counts were made here and those that continue to stand include 2,800 Brent Geese passing east on the 9<sup>th</sup> March 1996, 49 Shoveler east on the 10<sup>th</sup> Mar 1995, 13 Garganey east on the 15<sup>th</sup> April 2003, 29 Velvet Scoter east on the 21<sup>st</sup> April 2003, 111 Fulmar east on the 20<sup>th</sup> April 2003, 230 Whimbrel east on the 8<sup>th</sup> May 2001 and 366 Dunlin east on the 12<sup>th</sup> May 2002.

During an unprecedented influx into the county a record count of 11 Storm Petrels passed west on the 24<sup>th</sup> May 2006 and a total of 36 Manx Shearwaters heading east on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Jun 1999 was also a local record. From the autumn period an exceptional 560 Black Terns west on the 6<sup>th</sup> September 1992 and seven Little Auks east on the 14<sup>th</sup> November 1996 are still record totals, as are counts from around the point of 15 Shags on the 7<sup>th</sup> February 2004 and 16 Common Sandpipers on the 8<sup>th</sup> August 1994.

Rarer species involved the first only records to date of Gull-billed Tern (in July 1997) and Ring-billed Gull (in 1999 and 2001), with Long-tailed Duck, Smew, Balearic Shearwater, Leach's Petrel, Spoonbill, Montagu's Harrier, Goshawk, Red-footed Falcon, Spotted Redshank, Long-tailed Skua, Sabine's Gull, White-winged Black Tern and Puffin also of particular note.

Whilst attention was mainly focused on the sea, the first area record of Melodious Warbler was singing from bushes on the point in May 1995 (with another at Capel Battery the same day) and a Stone Curlew was seen on the beach on three dates in September/October 1990.

Continued watching of the site has seen the numbers of Mediterranean Gulls continue to increase with a new British record count of c.4,000 present in late August/early September 2020. Other more recent highlights have included White Stork, Cattle Egret, Great White Egret, Woodlark and Hawfinch.

Capel Battery (also known locally as the ‘Gun Site’) has also been regularly watched since the late 1980s and the former Battery Observation Post is an excellent vantage point for observing visual migration, whilst the surrounding scrub and trees provides cover for grounded migrants. Highlights here have included Alpine Swift, Bee-eater, Golden Oriole, Red-rumped Swallow, Tawny Pipit, Serin, Hawfinch and Common Rosefinch.

Purple Sandpipers formerly wintered in some numbers at the apron in Folkestone Warren, peaking at 27 in early 1986, and the first area record of Desert Wheatear was seen there on the 28<sup>th</sup> March 1998. A Spotted Crake frequented the small pond in Folkestone Warren in November/December 1982 and in June 2021 a flock of nine Bee-eaters were seen arriving in off the sea over the Warren.

## Access and parking

Copt Point can be accessed via Wear Bay Road where there is free on-road parking. To reach the Warren head north from Copt Point and take the first turning on the right onto the unnamed road that passes by Martello Tower number 1. Follow this track to its end where there are a couple of small, free car parks. Capel Battery is most easily accessed by parking on the eastern end of Crete Road East and taking the footpath that runs alongside the Valiant Sailor pub to the cliff top. The main Folkestone to Dover bus route passes the Valiant Sailor where there are stopping points.

## Bird species diversity

A long history of coverage has resulted in a total of 234 species being recorded within the tetrad, which ranks as the second richest in diversity amongst the 31 local tetrads as the table below demonstrates. The number of breeding and wintering species relate to those recorded in the 2007-2013 BTO/KOS atlas fieldwork.

## Other Natural History

Folkestone Warren has been designated as a Site of Special Scientific Interest (SSSI) as it is of considerable biological, geological and physiographical interest. It encompasses the range of marine and terrestrial habitats associated with the chalk cliffs, and with the underlying Gault clay and Lower Greensand exposed at the western end of the site. These habitats support outstanding assemblages of plants and invertebrates, together with individual species which are nationally uncommon.

On the cliff top there is a small area of chalk grassland, whilst on the chalk cliff ledges and slopes are plant species with a preference for maritime or calcareous habitats. Several are rare nationally and some with mainly continental distribution reach their northernmost point in Britain at this site. Their survival on this stretch of coast may be largely attributable to its warm, south facing, sheltered climate, which is comparable to that of regions several degrees latitude to the south. Many rare invertebrates breed within the site, representing several taxonomic groups and also including species with a preference for warm climates. The site is also a major landing place for migrant insects from the continent which may form temporary colonies.

Chalk is exposed for much of the length of the site, the underlying gault clay creates instability in the chalk and landslips occur from time to time resulting in a mosaic of cliff ledges, scree, bare faces and undercliffs, of varying slope and aspect. The cliff vegetation is predominantly calcareous grassland but scrub is present on the more stable undercliffs, and there is a characteristic assemblage of plant species at the spray-line which includes such national rarities as Sea-heath, Curved Hard-grass and Golden Samphire. Above the sprayline, plant species typical of calcareous grassland and of maritime habitats grow side by side, resulting in plant communities which are considered rare in Europe. Several nationally scarce plant species are represented here, including Wild Cabbage and the Dover variety of Nottingham Catchfly (*var. nutans*), whilst the humid climate favours the growth of species which inland are restricted to woodlands on calcareous soils, such as Stinking Iris and Wood Spurge.

The area of chalk grassland on the cliff top is chiefly dominated by Sheep's-fescue and Upright Brome, and a variety of herb species characteristic of chalk soils are present. These include Early and Late Spider-orchids, and Horseshoe Vetch *Hippocrepis comosa*, food plant of the larvae of the Adonis Blue butterfly, which breeds within the site.

The Gault and Lower Greensand cliffs at the western end of the site are unstable and sparsely vegetated. In the Warren, landslips have given rise to a succession of steep, broken slopes where scrub and woodland is developing and there are several small ponds. The combination of southerly aspect, chalk substratum and maritime influence of the site provides favourable conditions for a wide diversity of invertebrate species, several of which occur sparsely if at all outside south east England. These include the harvestman *Trogulus tricarinatus* and the millipede *Polydesmus testaceus*.

Collectors of butterflies were also active in Folkestone Warren in the nineteenth and twentieth centuries but, as with the bird records, details are rarely sufficient to allocate them to a specific tetrad. Chalmers-Hunt (1968) mentions two records of Apollo (in 1847 or 1848, and in 1955), two records of Swallowtail (in 1945 and 1953), several Black-veined Whites (but not since 1875), an influx of Berger's Clouded Yellows in 1947 and 1948, at least five Queen of Spain Fritillaries (but not since 1919), up to five Camberwell Beauties (but not since 1926) and a few Large Tortoiseshells (but not since 1875).

Grizzled Skipper and Bath White appear to have been resident in the Warren until the mid-1940s, as was Silver-studded Blue which appears to have disappeared in the late 1950s. The Grayling was described as common and the site was the last stronghold in the county of the species but there have been no records since 2014 and it too is feared to have become extinct. Silver-spotted Skipper, Dark Green Fritillary and Chalk Hill Blue were also present but never common.

Grazing has been reintroduced in the tetrad since 2017 and this has led to more regular sightings of Silver-spotted Skipper, whilst Chalk Hill Blue and Small Blue are also likely to benefit from this management. Other resident butterflies typical of chalk downland include Dingy Skipper, Wall, Green Hairstreak, Marbled White, Brown Argus and Adonis Blue. Clouded Yellows have frequently been recorded alongside the more regular migrants and a Silver-washed Fritillary was recorded in the Warren in August 2021, whilst a Swallowtail was seen at Capel Battery in August 2020.

The tetrad has an impressive moth list including a number of highly significant species. Fiery Clearwing was first discovered in Britain at Folkestone Warren in 1856 and this is still its best-known locality in the country, although it has recently been found to be present along the east and north Kent coasts. Sub-angled Wave also appears to have first been discovered here (in 1858) and the Warren is probably the only site in Britain where it is resident, although temporary populations have existed elsewhere in Kent and Sussex, and it is occasionally encountered on the nearby Downs and at Samphire Hoe. *Pempeliella ornatella* (Ornate Knot-horn) is now probably restricted in Britain to the Warren and Samphire Hoe, and the Burren in Ireland.

*Agdistis bennetii* (Saltmarsh Plume) is commonly found on saltmarshes in Britain, where it feeds on Common Sea-lavender (*Limonium vulgare*), but an isolated population exists at the Warren where it uses Rock Sea-lavender (*Limonium binervosum*). The adventive *Blastobasis rebeli* (Marsh Dowd), a native of Madeira first seen in Britain in Hampshire in 1998, was recorded in Kent for the first time at Folkestone Warren where it now appears to be established. Portland Ribbon Wave is another recent colonist that seems to have become established here.


Other chalk specialties include *Agonopterix rotundella* (Rolling Carrot Flat-body), *Acompsia schmidtiellus* (Marjoram Crest), *Eriopsela quadrana* (Four-spot Bell), *Selania leplastriana* (Cabbage Piercer), *Cochylimorpha alternana* (Kentish Conch), *Moitrelia obductella* (Kent Knot-horn), Orange-tailed Clearwing, Lace Border, Chalk Carpet, Galium Carpet, Barred Tooth-striped, Straw Belle, Clouded Buff, Cream-spot Tiger, Dew Moth, the Wormwood and Northern Rustic.

Also of note amongst the resident species are *Bisigna procerella* (Kent Tubic), *Cnaemidophorus rhododactyla* (Rose Plume), *Capperia britanniodactylus* (Wood-sage Plume), *Eupoecilia ambiguella* (Vine Moth), *Cydia microgrammana* (Rest-harrow Piercer), *Delplanqueia inscriptella* (Brown Powdered Knot-horn), *Mecyna asinalis* (Coastal Pearl), *Cynaeda dentalis* (Starry Pearl), the Festoon, Broken-barred Carpet, Mottled Grey, Golden-rod Pug, Orange Moth and Rest Harrow.

Notable migrants have comprised *Diasemiopsis ramburialis* (Vagrant China-mark), Convolvulus Hawk-moth, Rannoch Looper, Brussels Lace, Gypsy Moth, Small Marbled, Dark Crimson Underwing, Ni Moth, Golden Twin-spot, Bordered Straw, Scarce Bordered Straw, two Orache Moths in July 2022, Pale-shouldered Cloud, Small Mottled Willow and the only area record of Great Brocade in 2017.

Historical records from the Warren not specified to tetrad included Tawny Wave, Crimson Speckled and Red Sword-grass in the nineteenth century, and a Spurge Hawk-moth in 1937.

The only area record of Lesser Emperor occurred in the Warren on the 21<sup>st</sup> July 2012.

A colony of Common Wall Lizards can be found in the Little Switzerland area of the Warren. The species is considered not to be native to Britain, with the twenty or so colonies likely to have originated from deliberate releases. The Warren colony has been known since at least 2004 and is believed to have been abandoned by the pet trade as surplus stock. The reptiles are of the green-backed form and so probably originate from Italy.

The site contains one of the most important localities for marine interest between the Isle of Wight and Flamborough Head, by virtue of the combination of intertidal habitats and communities, and rare species which are present. Also of considerable interest are the plant and animal communities of the adjoining sublittoral zone.

The range of geological substrata exposed on the shore provides a diversity of intertidal habitats and these are colonised by a wide variety of marine plants and animals in characteristic assemblages. Many species found here are rare in south east England or nationally and reach their eastern limit of distribution in the Eastern Channel at this site.

The clay bands of the Lower Chalk form wave cut intertidal platforms in East Wear Bay and these clays support characteristic and unusual assemblages of small algal species with many ephemerals and including rarities such as *Scinaia furcellata* and *Derbesia tenuissima*, and species well outside their normal limits of distribution, such as *Chorda filum*.

Copt Point, formed principally of hard Lower Greensand, is a unique site in Kent and south-east England. It supports algal assemblages more typical of northern and western England including the fucoid algae *Pelvetia canaliculata* and *Ascophyllum nodosum*, which are very rare on natural substrata in the south-east. The intertidal fauna are also unusual for south east England, being particularly species-rich and with some species rarely recorded east of the Isle of Wight.

Whilst the SSSI boundary follows mean low water mark, there are also marine communities of interest on the lower shore and in the sublittoral. Off Copt Point the seabed is rocky but the presence of the sewage outfall has resulted in much of the area becoming dominated by extensive mats of mussels, upon which are feeding large numbers of starfish. In East Wear Bay the seabed is predominantly sandy, and supports polychaete worms, bivalve molluscs and many juvenile flat fish.

The exposed cliff section of Folkestone Beds and Gault at Copt Point represents the most important single locality for studying the sedimentology and stratigraphy of these formations in England. The sequence has been the focus of extensive research and represents the historical type section for both these rock types. This section of Gault Cliffs has yielded a selection of reptiles from several horizons and is considered to be the best Gault reptile site in Britain. The reptiles are often well localised, and they may be dated by abundant ammonites. The reptiles are mainly marine forms; turtles *Rhinochelys*, ichthyosaurs *Ophthalmosaurus*, plesiosaurs *Cimiliosaurus*, pliosaurs *Polyptychodon*, and pterosaurs *Ornithocheirus*. The East Wear Bay section has produced type specimens of several species, and fresh erosion maintains the potential of the site.

The area of coastal landslides which includes both chalk and clay has probably been more intensively studied than any other of comparable size in Britain. This is largely because it is crossed by the main Folkestone-Dover railway line, which on occasion has been displaced by slipping (notably in 1915), creating an immediate demand for detailed studies and monitoring. The site has suffered twelve major slips since 1765 and is now protected by a complex of coastal defence works whose long-term effect on the movements provides a field of future study.

A list of all species recorded in the tetrad is provided below in Appendix 2.

### General History

There is evidence that there was an extensive Iron Age settlement on the edge of East Wear Bay. Remains suggest that quern stones were produced here during the Iron Age on an almost industrial scale. The querns are made of the local greensand stones (or 'greenstones'), most likely collected or cut from Copt Point and taken to the headland to be worked. Over 60 quern stones have been recovered from the site and the majority are unfinished, with partially worked surfaces, or incomplete hoppers and spindle holes. In many cases, the querns appear to have been damaged and discarded, many seeming to have fractured during the hole-boring stage. In addition to the numerous broken or unfinished querns, a layer of the excavation strata at the site is entirely composed of greensand dust, which is almost certainly stone-working debris, suggesting that this was the location of an Iron Age quern workshop. Querns constructed of Folkestone greensand have been found in numerous other archaeological excavations, including local Kentish sites and further afield.

By c. 75 AD, the Iron Age settlement had been replaced with a Roman villa. The original villa was around 65 metres in length and the main rooms had *opus signinum* flooring. It appears that portions of the original villa were gutted by fire, leading to it being rebuilt and a second construction added at around the same time (under part of the rebuilt villa is a 6cm layer of burnt material). The rebuilt villa appears to have been a luxurious residence with a hypocaust heating system, a bath complex and a tessellated mosaic floor. The site was first excavated by Samuel Winbolt in 1924 but by then part of the site was already crumbling over the cliffside. Further excavations were undertaken between 2010 and 2012 by Canterbury Christ Church University.


The tetrad contains Martello Tower numbers 1 and 3 of 74 which were built (and are numbered sequentially) along the coastline between here and Seaford, Sussex. The towers, which were built in 1806 to meet the threat of invasion from Napoleonic France, are situated to the east of Wear Bay Road: one near the entrance road to the Warren and one on the golf course near the Coastguard lookout station (number 2 is located in between, but further west into the tetrad TR23 I). Number 1 is being converted into a private residence. Number 3 was formerly used as a visitor centre but is currently closed. It was modified during World War II with the addition of an observation post on the roof.

The Valiant Sailor, which sits prominently at the top of the Dover Hill road, was built as a farmhouse in 1780 by Thomas Baker who was granted a lease on the land from Lord Radnor and opened as a public house in 1782 as "The Jolly Sailor", gaining its current name in 1820. The nautical moniker reflects its patronage by fisherman and sailors from Folkestone and Dover.

Following the German invasion of France the Capel Battery was built in 1941 on the cliff tops to the west of Capel-le-Ferne. Much of the site is within this tetrad but it also extends into TR23 P. The battery comprised three 8" guns to provide anti-shipping defensive fire into the English Channel and associated supporting accommodation. The site is now under private ownership and a museum is being created, with planned access to the number 3 gun and the underground plotting room and underground dressing station.
