Oberhasli Specialty Show Guidelines

The following guidelines and application were developed in order to choose the most appropriate organization to host the Oberhasli Specialty Show in each District. Since the hosts will be chosen on a merit basis from the applications, it is important that all the questions be answered accurately. Thanks!

The OBA will normally approve no more than one host per year in each ADGA District. Exceptions may be made if:

- * one of the hosts applies for a buck show sanction only, and the other does not offer a buck show, or—
- * the host shows are separated by a great distance
- (preferably 350 miles or more) and by at least six days, or-
- * both hosts applied for a sanction the previous year without receiving it.

A host organization may not sponsor a Oberhasli Specialty Show for two (2) consecutive years, unless no other organization in that district applies for one.

The show must not be restricted in any way. It must be open to all exhibitors regardless of age, club membership, or place of residence. Any premiums or prizes offered by the club, state or local authority must be paid to any winner regardless of where they reside. All ADGA rules shall govern.

The OBA will provide awards for ADGA GCH and ADGA ResCH for each show sanctioned, as well as for Best of Breed where a Champion Challenge class is offered. The host organization is strongly encouraged to provide ribbons/rosettes or trophies stating the show is the "Oberhasli Specialty Show for District _#_."

Along with complete show results, the host organization is required to return to the OBA Specialty Show Chairperson within sixty days of the end of the show photographs of the ADGA GCH, ResCH and the Best of Breed (if offered) of each sanctioned show, each correctly identified. These photos become the property of the OBA and will not be returned. They will be displayed on the OBA website and published in the OBA's newsletter as soon as possible. Depending on the timing of the show and of the special breed issues of the periodicals, they may also be sent to the special breed issues of the *United Caprine News* and the *Dairy Goat Journal*. With all this publicity exposure, you'll want to send high quality photos.

An application fee of \$50 (\$20 if the sanction is to be for bucks only), made payable to the OBA, is required with the application. Half of this will be will be refunded if the completed Show Report and required correctly identified pictures are received by the Specialty Show Chairman within sixty (60) days of the end of the show. The checks of the shows which applied for but did not receive sanctions will be returned.

Applications are accepted through March 31 for shows in the year you are applying for. Hosts selected will be notified as soon as possible. Send the application to the OBA Specialty Show Chairperson.
