Waking up early, one bright and sunny morning, while still lying in my bed, I began to worship and praise my heavenly Father quietly with my whole heart and in my mouth, (in reference to Ps, 9:1; 34:1; 138:2). <sup>with</sup> <sup>while again</sup> <sup>beginning</sup> <sup>to feel the</sup> <sup>awesome</sup> <sup>sensation</sup> <sup>of my spirit</sup> <sup>then</sup> <sup>gently rising</sup> <sup>up again, as</sup> <sup>I experienced</sup> <sup>the first time,</sup> <sup>yet not so</sup> <sup>intensely</sup> <sup>\*(NOTE I Cor.</sup> <sup>15: 39-51)</sup> <sup>See my Testi</sup> <sup>mony of</sup> <sup>Rising up's</sup> <sup>Lift up (Chapt.</sup> <sup>5 Part I)</sup>

without any foreknowledge of what soon would occur, for this was an extraordinarily new experience for me. (in reference to Is, 42:16), (as with all of my experiences of Christ and of God, as in Chapters 4-15; My Testimonies of Christ and of God: Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation, which all began in the year 1977), and with no other thought, except that of praising my Lord and Savior, (note John 4:23,24), I suddenly experienced greatly, wonderfully and amazingly, supernaturally and miraculously, the physical sensation of "the peace of God" permeated and spread abundantly within my <sup>and throughout entire</sup> <sup>body,</sup> in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, in reference to Ps, 37:11; Jer, 29:9; I Cor, 2:1-16, specifically verse 4; Heb, 5:11-14! \*Note I Cor, 15:39-51!

As my body was suddenly and completely overtaken powerfully by the

Eph. 1:3, which is, truly, hard to express in words, (in reference to Heb.  
5:11-14)! For this experience was beyond imagination!

In the attempt to be more specific, this spiritual experience was the  
extreme sensation of overwhelmingly and divinely melting with warmth as  
butter and honey melting in the warm sun-light! (Note Is. 7:22) As  
extremely, ultimately, and without measure, my entire body, literally,  
transformed, as it grew increasingly heavenly and spiritually soft and  
fluidic, as angelic and celestial clay mixed with water! (Note Rom. 9:21)

Altogether, I experienced God's heavenly and divine peace flowing  
within me like a river, and, with this, I experienced the glory of God, as  
in light, flowing within me like a stream, (in reference to Is. 66:12)!

This spiritual blessing in heavenly places of the peace and glory of God in reference to Eph. 3:3, was and is a feeling of being completely without the feeling and weight of a natural body; but rather, a spiritual and heavenly body. As my whole body felt extremely, spiritually and divinely light in weight, while I experienced God's, truly, abundant peace and heavenly rest, witnessing every muscle in my body being greatly loosened and untied, as they were being freed from all natural tension and restraint. (in reference to Mat. 11:28-30)! In fact, in my normal state, I felt heavy and tense in comparison to this marvelous and remarkable work and act of God, which was in demonstration of the Spirit and of power. (in reference to I Cor. 2:4).

In comparison to natural peace, which is earthly, and God's peace, which is heavenly, God's divine and heavenly peace surpasses, exceeds, and magnifies the sensation of natural peace thousand's of times times thousand's of times greater in degree and in intensity! God's heavenly and spiritual peace, which is extremely and wonderfully comforting, (in reference to John 14:15-27), makes natural peace, even at its best, seem quite rigid, tense, and even nervous! Truly, this was a feeling of peace not as the world gives, (in reference to John 14:27)! As my body physically felt not of this world, (in reference to John 17:16)! In other words, this supernatural, spiritual, divine peace, and celestial, heavenly rest is beyond the normal and natural experience of natural man! This is the peace of God that pass all understanding, (in reference to Phil. 4:7)!

Therefore, this experience, including my other~~d~~ experiences, (as in Chapters 4-15; My Testimonies of Christ and of God; Scriptures of
