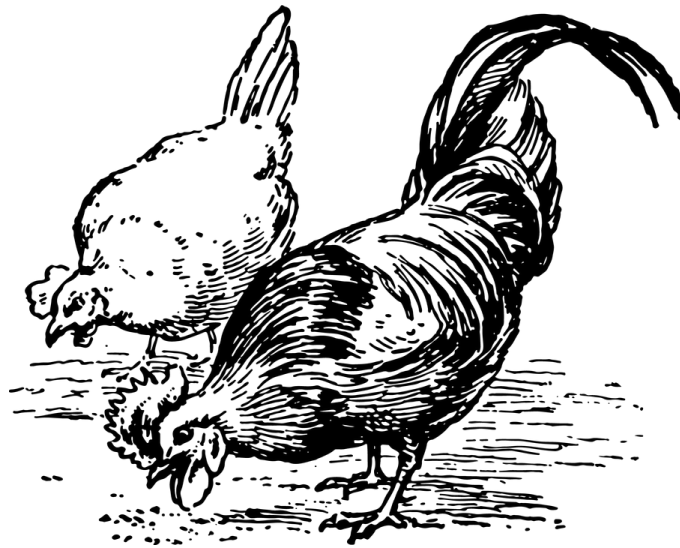

**JUDGING TAKES PLACE 10:00 am on TUESDAY, JULY 23**

Poultry shows represent a means of disease spread from flock to flock. With this in mind, the Department of Agriculture and Marketing has been requested by Exhibitors to establish and enforce minimum standards of health at shows under provincial jurisdiction within the Province of Nova Scotia.

Different diseases affect different species of poultry. For this reason, the policy divides poultry according to biological order, and policies vary with orders. Biological orders and example species:

- ANSERIFORMS - ducks, geese, etc.
- GALLIFORMES - chickens, etc.
- COLUMBIFORMES - pigeons, etc.

### **PROGRAM**

1. Decisions to refuse admittance of any entry to the show because of poor health can be appealed to the Department of Agriculture Veterinarian. His decision is final.
2. All mortality and birds showing poor health during the show will be reported by the Show Manager to the Dept. of Agriculture Show Supervisor. The Show Supervisor will inspect these birds and if he feels it is warranted he will remove them from the Show and dispose of them by appropriate methods.
3. Show Management and Exhibitors are responsible for accounting for all birds to the Show Supervisor.
4. No bird can be removed from the Show prior to the end of the Show without written permission of the Board of Directors.
5. **Exhibits can be delivered to the Exhibition between 2:00 pm and 8:00 pm, Sunday July 21 and before noon on Monday July 22. Exhibits can be taken out between 5:00 pm and 8:30 pm Sunday, July 28**
6. If there are any birds left in the barn after 8:30 pm Sunday, July 28, 2019, they will be the sole responsibility of the owner.
7. Stationary coops and drinking cups are furnished by the Exhibition.
8. No birds that are not up to standard will be given prizes.
9. Only 3 entries per section for Classes 49, 50 sections 1-24, & Class 51 sections 1-25.
10. If you are requiring more entry forms, please contact the Exhibition Office at 902 543-3341 to make arrangements.
