Monday: Please send your child to school in white! We will be twirling and howling like March wind carrying the clouds across the sky!

Tuesday: The Click Beetle tries and tries until he can jump and land on his feet, not an easy task for a young click beetle. What is your child learning to do? Send them to school with a Show-and-Tell item that will lend to our lesson focused on working steadily at your goals. Or, if you don't have an item to send, talk to your child about something they try hard to do (writing their name, tying their shoes, washing their hands, etc.) to draw a connection to the click beetle.
