

The Creighton Model Fertility Care System (CrMs) is a method of family planning which follows the teachings of the Catholic Church and Nature's Law and can be used to achieve or avoid pregnancy. The CrMs can also be used as a solution to infertility, miscarriage, ovarian cysts, irregular cycles, hormone problems, premenstrual syndrome and usual bleeding.

This system works by using standardized observations and the charting of biological markers that our body naturally produces every month to interpret a woman's health and fertility.
