right hand, the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us.

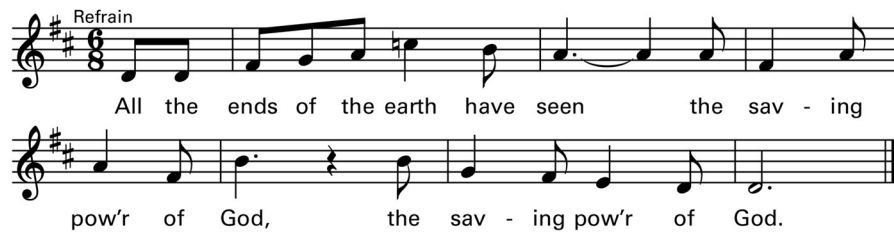

A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO LUKE 3:15-16, 21-22

Nicene Creed: I believe in one God, the Father almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.
