Rev. Anne Ribbins Russ is a member of Calvary Hill Missionary Baptist Church where her brother, Rev. John W. Ribbins III is pastor. At her home church, Rev. Russ serves as Minister of Music & Worship and Bible study teacher. Other responsibilities include

Rev. Russ and her brothers, Rev. John Ribbins III and Rev. Mark Ribbins, share a legacy of religious service, both grandfathers, two uncles, and their mother (Gertrude) were ministers of the Gospel. Her parents, Gertrude and John Ribbins Jr. were the founders of Ribbins Book Store, an enterprise which provided Christian literature, music and supplies for local churches until 1999. She served as Chief Operating Officer for the business and specialized in Biblical research as well as being a consultant for religious literature and music. As a Christian Education consultant Rev. Russ developed programs for individual churches, district and state organizations. She has preached, lectured, taught and ministered throughout the state.

After receiving the Master of Divinity degree, she was a professor of Theological studies and Liberal Arts at Temple Bible College and Seminary, Cleveland Extension. She also served as Dean of Student Affairs and later as Assistant Academic Dean. Another facet of her work in education came as an administrator for grades 7-12 at the Second New Hope Christian School.

She is a native of Cleveland, Ohio and was educated in the Cleveland Public School system. Rev. Russ is a mother, and grandmother.





Rita Little is a native of St. Louis, Missouri, but Cleveland has been her home for over thirty years. She is a retired registered nurse and a retired elementary school teacher. Rita was blessed to have had two careers she dearly loved and enjoyed. She obtained a Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from Cleveland State University. She later obtained a Masters Degree in Early Childhood Education from Kent State University. She has taken numerous Moody Bible Courses down through the years.
