The parties have stipulated to the relief contained in this order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED at follows:

- The Sweet Extension Drain Drainage District and the Sweet and Branches Drain
 Drainage District are separate drainage districts.
 - 2. The Sweet Extension Drain and Sweet and Branches Drain are separate drains.
- 3. For purposes of calculating expenditures allowed under MCL 280.196(4), the Sweet Extension Drain is currently 3.66 miles and therefore an annual expenditure amount of \$20,000 for maintenance and repair of the drain, exclusive of inspection and engineering fees and the cost of publication and mailing, is authorized.
- 4. For purposes of calculating assessments allowed under MCL 280.196(7), the Sweet Extension Drain is currently 3.66 miles and therefore an annual assessment amount of \$20,000 for maintenance and repair of the drain, exclusive of inspection and engineering fees and the cost of publication and mailing, is authorized.
- 5. The equitable motion filed by Plaintiff is dismissed without prejudice. Plaintiff shall review the accounting documents provided by Defendants and notify Defendants if any issues remain pending.
