STIPULATED ORDER DISMISSING MOTION AND OTHER RELIEF

At a session of said Court, held in the Courthouse thereof, in

The parties have stipulated to the relief contained in this order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED at follows:

1. The Sweet Extension Drain Drainage District and the Sweet and Branches Drain Drainage District are separate drainage districts.


2. The Sweet Extension Drain and Sweet and Branches Drain are separate drains.

3. For purposes of calculating expenditures allowed under MCL 280.196(4), the Sweet Extension Drain is currently 3.66 miles and therefore an annual expenditure amount of \$20,000 for maintenance and repair of the drain, exclusive of inspection and engineering fees and the cost of publication and mailing, is authorized.

4. For purposes of calculating assessments allowed under MCL 280.196(7), the Sweet Extension Drain is currently 3.66 miles and therefore an annual assessment amount of \$20,000 for maintenance and repair of the drain, exclusive of inspection and engineering fees and the cost of publication and mailing, is authorized.

5. The equitable motion filed by Plaintiff is dismissed without prejudice. Plaintiff shall review the accounting documents provided by Defendants and notify Defendants if any issues remain pending.
