Summer Camp Requirements

- All campers MUST have **updated paperwork** turned in to confirm registration (Includes new to Springer's or if current paperwork on file is expired)
- Campers MUST be **4 years old** to attend

Field Trip Information (Preteen Camp only 4th -7th grade)

- If you register for an optional field trip, you are financially responsible for that spot whether your child attends or not. **Field trips will be confirmed closer to the start of camp.**
- **Included in Tuition:** Water days, speakers, presentations, air bounces, water slides, interactivities, game trucks, crafts, in-house entertainers, and activities we have scheduled for campers at the gym. **Water day schedule will be provided closer to camp or on weekly parent outlines and are for ALL campers.**

Food

- Campers MUST bring lunch, snacks, and drinks daily to camp. Refillable water bottles **ARE REQUIRED** by every camper daily. **Bring lots of water in a refillable water bottle, thermos or cooler labeled with child's name daily.**
- A daily snack bar will be available. **All items are \$1.00**
- Water fountains are **NOT** being used at this time.

Behavior Correction

1st Offense: Verbal correction

2nd Offense: Time out reflection period / incident report signed by parent

3rd Offense: Parent conference

4th Offense: Privileges take away / Parents notified (Activities, presentations, in-house shows, field trips)

5th Offense: Possible dismissal from Springer's Summer Camp and account balance will be due **IMMEDIATELY** upon dismissal

****Any violent or inappropriate behavior will be grounds for immediate dismissal and account balance will be due immediately upon dismissal****

Behavior Policy

First and foremost, your child's safety is our utmost importance at Springer's. To ensure the safety and enjoyment of every camper at Springer's, rules will be strictly enforced. If behavior becomes an issue, dismissal from Springer's Summer Camp with payment of remaining summer camp account balance being required upon dismissal may be necessary.

Attendance Policy

Every full time/full summer (Registered for all 11 weeks of summer camp) camper is allowed 1 week vacation per summer. Tuition is required to be paid for every week your family is registered for, regardless of attendance, minus the week we are closed and 1 vacation week (for full time campers only). If you are registered for optional field trips (if applicable), you are responsible for payment even if your child does not attend. If you have a past due balance on your account, your child will not be allowed to attend field trips and their spot will be offered to another child from waiting list.

***** After May 1st, families are financially responsible for the weeks registered for regardless of attendance. No registration adjustments will be considered after May 1, 2023.**

Prices include all in-house presentations, shows, activities, interactives, and water days. Optional field trip costs, if applicable, are **NOT** included.

Payment Policy

Camp tuition will be charged to all accounts weekly. Late fees will be added if tuition is not paid by the weekly due date. You may pay by cash, check, or online by debit/credit card. There is a 5% transaction fee added to all payments made online through parent portal using debit/credit cards. Springer's only accepts Discover, MasterCard, & Visa Card payments online. Paying by cash/check directly to Springer's eliminates the 5% transaction fee. Your account is available 24/7 online for your convenience. Access your account through your parent portal located on our website at www.flipatspringers.com. If you prefer to use weekly autopay, please fill in auto pay information in your parent portal and send the Executive Director/Owner an e-mail letting them know you would like to use the autopay feature for your weekly tuition payment to avoid late fees.

There is a \$50 administrative fee charged for registration changes or cancellations to accounts once registered. A 3-week drop notice is required once camp begins.

Space for summer camp is limited, therefore, once you register for a week, you take someone else's spot. Please be aware you are financially responsible for the weeks you register for regardless of attendance. (Only full time/full summer, all 11 weeks, students are eligible for one vacation week. Part time students or students registered for less than 11 weeks of camp DO NOT qualify. Vacation week is only applicable towards summer camp (does not carry over to after school care).

In addition to camp policies, Springer's Gymnastics LLC operational policies **MUST** be always adhered to.
