Help us, help you. If you have video surveillance equipment, please make sure it is in working order and turned on.

A reminder:

Be alert! If you see someone acting suspiciously in your neighborhood, call the Sheriff's Office immediately. If possible get description or license plate number, slip number for boats, and/or make of vehicle. Don't wait until the next day and don't try confronting the person yourself. In some of our investigations, if we had received a call right way, we may have been able to apprehend the suspect as he was perpetrating the crimes
