Quilt Show Entry Form Guidelines One Entry Form for each submitted item must be received by August 10, 2020

Quilt Entry Rules

- 1. Any <u>active</u> Lick Skillet Quilt Guild (LSQG) member who has paid membership dues by the end of March 2020 is eligible to enter with no entry fee. This is a judged show; however, you may elect to not have your quilts judged. Entries for non-members will be accepted with an entry fee of \$15 for the first quilt and \$10 for each additional quilt entered to be judged. Non-member entry forms must be postmarked by August 2, 2020 and mailed to LSQG, Care of: Carolyn Davis, 3030 Airport Road, Oxford, AL 36203. Entry fees must be included with entry forms. There will be no entry fees for quilts entered in the display only category.
- 2. No more than 6 quilts may be entered by an individual, unless you are a member entering a quilt in the member challenge category. Those members will be allowed 7 entries.
- 3. Only quilts which are clean, undamaged, odor-free, and neatly pieced and quilted may be entered in the show. LSQG reserves the right to refuse entry of any quilt not meeting these requirements.
- 4. Each quilt entered to be judged <u>must</u> have never been entered in a previous Lick Skillet Quilt Guild quilt show judged category.
- 5. A 4" sleeve <u>must be sewn</u> onto the backs of all quilts, edge to edge. Quilts without a sleeve will be returned to the owner. For quilts longer than 96", the top edge of the sleeve must be sewn 96" from the floor.
- 6. Entries <u>must</u> have 3 layers: fabric top, batting, and backing, except yo-yo and cathedral window quilts. No quilts can be tied except those entered in the Junior category. No framed pieces are eligible.
- 7. Each quilt <u>must be identified with a label</u>, including owner's name and name of quilt, sewn or fused to the back of quilt. Labels should be covered with a piece of muslin fabric covering the information on the label.
- 8. No purchased quilts are eligible however, purchased kits and/or Block of the Month quilts will be eligible.
- 9. A 4"x6" photo <u>must</u> be stapled to the registration form. On the back of the photo include member's name and title of the quilt. Photos are for layout, identification and publicity purposes. Photos will not be returned.
- 10. The quilt show committee reserves the right to choose the entries used as display only quilts if more entries are received than can be exhibited.
- 11. Select categories of entry in accordance with the guidelines set forth in the list of quilt entry categories. Those not marked will be placed in the display only category.
- 12. Design source of inspiration <u>must</u> be included on the form.
- 13. LSQG leadership reserves the right to change category of any entry.
- 14. Best of Show will be chosen from the 1st place winners.
- 15. Deadline for member entry forms is Monday, August 10, 2020.
- 16. Quilts are to be turned in on Monday, September 14th between 9 a.m. and 7 p.m. at the Oxford Civic Center, Room 101. Out of town entries may be shipped after September 3, 2020 by US mail and must be received by September 10, 2020. Shipping address is LSQG, care of Carolyn Davis, 3030 Airport Road, Oxford, AL 36203. Your quilt(s) will be returned to you in the same packaging material in which they were received. All mailed quilts will receive an email confirmation from the guild. If you wish for your quilt(s) to be returned to you via mail, you must include a prepaid label with return insured postage. If you are shipping your quilt(s) but intend to pick them up at the close of the show, you must present the email confirmation.
- 17. Each quilt entered <u>must be submitted in a pillowcase or other cotton bag with your name and phone number</u> on the outer opening of the case or bag. No plastic bags will be accepted.
- 18. Judging will be held Tuesday, September 15 & 16, 2020. All decisions of the judge are final.
- 19. Quilts <u>must</u> be picked up on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>September 19</u>, <u>after 4:30 p.m.</u> at the Oxford Civic Center. The owner of each quilt <u>must</u> either pick up their quilt(s) herself/himself <u>or</u> give written permission and receipt to the person responsible for picking up quilt(s).
