Welcome to the 41st Motorcycle Rally of the Motorcycle section of the Auckland Veteran & Vintage Car Club.

The rally begins on Friday at 6:00pm at the Clubrooms in Penrose for a pie and pud night. The actual rally is centred again on the Ramarama Hall at 13 Maher Road, Opaheke, Ramarama exit 466.

The ride: There is a longer ride of about 110 miles and a shorter ride of about 90 miles. We plan two points of interest on the route including a visit to the huge South African steam locomotives currently stationed at Mercer. There is a small cost for the stops which is built into your rally fee.

Start: From Ramarama Hall at 9:15am with briefing at 9:00am.
The two visits planned are located a few minutes ride apart.
Lunch: Is planned to be at a local school. This may prove to be impossible or may change due to Covid rules of the day.
Dinner: Will be held at the Clubrooms in Penrose at 6:30pm.
Covid: If part or all of the rally is cancelled the cost will be refunded. Entrants will be advised of any changes by email.



Important

You will need to be fully vaccinated to attend this rally. We will check this when you register and pick up your rally pack at the Ramarama Hall on Saturday or you can email a scanned copy of it with your entry.

A receipt will be sent to you shortly after your entry arrives. Please check the details on the receipt carefully. A "not-before" start time will be advised on the receipt but your actual start time advised on your rally pack may be later because we now use slowest first to sequence the start times and we do not know the final sequence until entries close. For any special requests for specific start times please send a request with the entry form. Organisers reserve the right to start any vehicle at any time. Note also that the system checks your financial status so please make sure your VCC subs are paid. Late entries if accepted, also guest riders and unpaid members are not eligible for prizes.

Accommodation

Essentially you need to organise your own accommodation. If you will not be attending any functions in Penrose, you may want somewhere in the Tuakau area. The Tuakau Hotel has undergone renovation for a number of years and is restored to its colonial appearance and the staff are also extremely helpful.

The hotel can accommodate up to 50 singles in a range of options in rooms above the Hotel or in the studio apartments next to the hotel. They also have 3 5-person cabins on the banks of the Waikato River next to the Tuakau Bridge which can accommodate 15 people. Beautiful views of the river.
