Juniper Early Learning Center is fundraising with Purdy's Chocolatier, just in time for Easter!

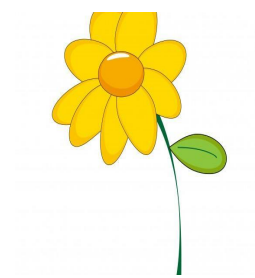
