



<b>1 MAGNUS MAXIMUS</b>	Very shiny. <u>Very</u> fit (showing ribs) Bright / relaxed paddock. Scope. Clear pick of the paddock. Taken down slowly (a bit free). <b>Recommended when still easy to back at 50-1 (SP 25-1)</b>	
2 TOOFI	Very fit (slight showing of ribs). Relaxed / bright. Small / growing. Wend down quite well.	
3 NAADIRR	Done some work. Bit immature. Small / well made / attractive / scope. Keen but not pulling canter.	
4 HIGHLAND ACCLAIM	Fit. Nervous preliminaries. Went down last and immature canter.	
5 ONE CHANCE	Active sort. Small / useful filly. Free to post.	
6 WEDDING RING	Bordering on very fit. Bright paddock. Pulling / free to post. This filly probably burnt too much of her powder in Dubai.	
7 BON VOYAGE	Fit. Relaxed / bright.	
8 QUICKASWECAN	Very fit. Relaxed pre-parade but bit on his toes padd. Slowly to post.	
9 MUIR LODGE	Very fit. Showing sharp ribs. Small / short backed.	
0 CROWDMANIA	Very fit. Relaxed preliminaries. Slowly down to post.	
0 STEELE RANGER	Very fit. Pulled going down.	
0 HATHA HOOH L SCRUTINI	Done some work. Immature preliminaries, 2 handlers paddock. Very fit. Bright / relaxed paddock. Pulled going down.

**1 TOP TUG**

Shiny. Fit (2<sup>nd</sup> start, 2014). Very attractive colt / plenty of scope. Alert / relaxed (much better than on seasonal debut) preliminaries. Taken down slowly / went down well. **Recommended at 4-1**  
This colt strikes me as a 100+ performer, perhaps even a colt who steps up to black type races later in the season. He ran off 84 here and it will be interesting to see his new handicap mark, as this is a very tricky race to rate. My guess is he will be moved up to 90 and the runner-up move up to 99 (from 95).

**2 CLOUDSCAPE**

Extremely fit (slight showing of ribs). Bright / relaxed. Went down last / taken down slowly / with some zest.

**3 STORMARDAL**

Very fit.

**4 DEVILMENT**

Very shiny / dappled. Very fit . Cantered with zest.

**5 BREMNER**

Fit (2<sup>nd</sup> start, 2014). Nervous (grinding) pre-parade. Keen canter. Showing ribs. Attractive sort with scope.

**6 FAMOUS KID**

Bordering on very fit. Relaxed paddock. Bit keen canter, and very difficult to load stalls.

**L BARYE**

Fit. Seasonal debut. Alert. Attractive / plenty of scope. Taken down slowly / positive canter.

**2 TOSCANINI**                      Very fit. Relaxed / bright paddock (edgy before stalls). Nice colt with scope.

**3 DICK WHITTINGTON**                      Shiny. Very fit. Bright / alert (a little edgy at times). Strong sort.

**4 NAFAQA**                      Debut. No paddock notes. Difficult to load stalls. Missed the break but was quite soon in touch with the field (the early pace was not strong, so that he could get up so quickly may have been misleading – still, this was an impressive racecourse debut).

**5 JUSTICE WELL**                      Fit. Looked well. Played up a bit again, probably remembering the mishap in the paddock at Newmarket on his debut (see May 31).

**6 CORDERO**                      Debut. Fit. Relaxed / alert. Scope.

Shiny. Very fit. Alert / relaxed and has grown up mentally now, behaving much better in the paddock (she bypassed the pre-parade ring).

**Recommended EW at 7-2 (SP 5-2)**

Extremely fit. Alert pre-parade / bit edgy paddock.

Fit. Relaxed / bright. Small / dipped back. Not well made. Typical heavy ground type.

Bordering on very fit. Leggy filly.

Bordering on very fit. Bright. Small / light / no scope.

Grinding a lot in preliminaries. Sweat between hind legs.
