# DAY ONE

Start your adventure in Goobies at noon for lunch at Irving Big Stop. Once you are ready, take route 210 to Swift Current for your first stop at Kilmory Resort. Spend your afternoon enjoying their kayak rentals or hiking in Garden Cove.

When you return to your accommodation, enjoy a quiet evening relaxing as you cook supper in one of Kilmory Resort's fully equipped cabins. From the deck, enjoy views of the water and the many marine animals who are neighbours of Kilmory.

# DAY TWO

Your second day starts with a coffee and a walk along the beach at Kilmory Resort. An hour's drive down the peninsula will bring you to the small community of Boat Harbour, where you can visit the Livyers Lot Economuseum and enjoy lunch at the Tea Rose Eatery.

In the afternoon, visit the beautiful community of Petite Forte to enjoy the lifestyle of a small Newfoundland town.



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Finish the afternoon with a walk through historical Burin and enjoy the views from their community boardwalk.

Enjoy supper at Smugglers Cove Roadhouse Patio-Bar & Grill. Visit their own old western village right on site.

After dinner, check into the Ocean View Motel in St. Lawrence.

## DAY THREE

Have breakfast at the hotel's onsite restaurant, Rita's Kitchen. Your next stop will be a visit with Laurentian Legacy Tours; take your pick of tour according to your interests: Tidal Wave or Chambers Cove.

Pick up a picnic lunch at The Lunch Tin Cafe before taking off for your afternoon adventure.

For those who are looking for an outdoor excursion, check out Allan's Island or Sandy Cove Beach. If you'd prefer to explore some of the Burin Peninsula's indoor activities, visit The Fortune Head Geology Centre.

Finish off the afternoon with a tea in Fortune at the Heritage House, before heading to a beautiful dinner at the Copper Kettle. End your evening with a visit to the Grand Bank Theatre Company for a show filled with local talent.

Check into Hotel Fortune for your last night's stay.

Wake up in beautiful Fortune and enjoy breakfast at the Burin Peninsula Motel. As you leave Grand Bank, be sure to take the scenic route home and drive through Frenchman's Cove.

To make the most of your last morning on 'The Boot,' take some time to either walk around downtown Grand Bank, visit the Provincial Seamen's Museum and Memorial, or stop in Grande Meadows Golf course for a one on one lesson.

As you pass back through Marystown, stop and dine at one of their many restaurants. Finish up your trip with a return to Goobies and the Trans Canada Highway.
