**GOSPEL:** Matthew 26:14—27:66

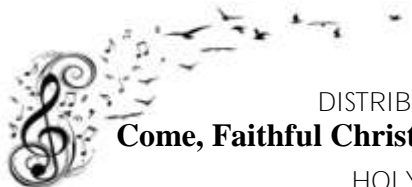

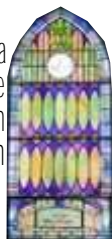
## New Storm Windows
