She will be giving two different workshops in which pedal and lever harpists will enjoy learning to "jazz up" their tunes. Other topics will include easy arranging for pop and religious music, and a little jazz harmony. You may attend either workshop, but Felice will give a discount on her merchandise to anyone who attends both.

The workshops will be held in the social hall of Aspinwall Presbyterian Church, 299 Center Avenue, Aspinwall PA, 15215, beginning at 12:30 PM and again at 3:00 PM. Can you tie a proper knot in a harp string, or do you get someone to do it for you? Do you know how to change a string quickly in the middle of a performance?

How long can you leave your harp in a car on a hot day? Have you ever seen someone change a pedal rod? Find



out the answers to these and other questions from master harp technician Tom Bell.
