TREASURE HUNT

This will be a "treasure hunt" to search for word clues with visual objects that point to a scripture passage, character or story in the Bible. This game can be played as a family or with a group of children.

Find a scripture, character, or story in the Bible to use for the final "treasure".

Visual treasure clue ideas: (These will to be put with each word sentence clue)

- Objects in the house or outside
- Cut out pictures in magazines
- Hand drawn pictures

Hide all the clues with their objects in secret places and leave the first word sentence clue as the children's starting point.

Start with the first word sentence clue for the children to find.

Each clue will give a clue to where the next clue is hidden...and so on.

The children will collect all their objects and put them together at the end of the search to try and figure out what the scripture, character or story is.

For younger children, you can word the clues to tell them where to go to find the next clue.

For older children you can word the clues like a riddle to have them figure out where they will be going to find the next clue.
