Thank you so much for taking the time to learn more about the Purchase Area 4th Day Community. Our community consists of three distinct Christian-renewal ministries - The Walk to Emmaus, Chrysalis, and Face to Face. All of the ministries are bathed in prayer and have the same purpose - to inspire, challenge, and equip the local church members for Christian action in their homes, churches, communities, and places of work. All participants are sponsored by someone who has already experienced one of the ministries. Each of the ministries is led by both clergy and lay leaders and is open to all denominations.

- 1. <u>The Walk to Emmaus</u> this ministry is for Christian adults who wish to strengthen their walk with Christ and strengthen their work in the local church. It is a 72-hour experience held two times per year (spring and fall) at BASIC training in Hardin, Kentucky.
- 2. <u>Chrysalis</u> this ministry is for Christian teens ages 15 (having completed their freshman year in high school) through college sophomores, who desire spiritual renewal to continue their involvement in their local church. Chrysalis is held two times per year (June and January) at Broadway Methodist Church in Paducah, Kentucky. It begins on Saturday morning and ends on Monday evening. It is always held on MLK, Jr. weekend in January so that students do not miss school.
- 3. Face to Face Encounter this is a new ministry for us, having our first Encounter in May of 2016. The Encounter is an adaptation of the Walk to Emmaus specifically to meet the needs of older Christian adults, ages 60 or older. In the Encounter, they experience Jesus through flexible daytime sessions in a local church, covering topics such as discipleship, mission, grief, and end-of-life issues.
