## God's People Confess Their Sin

Almighty, eternal God and Father, we confess and acknowledge to You that we were conceived in unrighteousness and are full of sin and transgression in all our life. We neither fully believe Your Word nor follow Your holy commandments. Remember Your goodness, we humbly ask You, and for the sake of Your Name, be gracious unto us, and forgive us our iniquity which, alas, is great. Beneath the cross of Christ we come to know that ours is the guilt, but Yours the forgiveness; ours the condemnation, but Yours the gift of justification; ours the bondage, yet Yours the freedom of adoption and new obedience. Even the faith by which we profess our dear Saviour's sacrifice was itself won for us by His death. Therefore, we cry out to You in sorrow for our sins and in thanksgiving for Your gift. Give us the grace, we pray, to receive again this word of the cross, which alone can refresh us on our pilgrim way and send us out again into the world.


