ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS:

1. GPA must be 2.5 or higher;
2. Family income \$100,000.00 or less. Proof of income REQUIRED - i.e., W-2
3. Must be entering college/university/training institution from high school in the Fall of 2020 and or FIRST YEAR college and submit official acceptance notification;
4. Must pursue courses leading to an undergraduate degree or certification; 5. Maximum age limit is 25 years old.

THE SELECTION PROCESS:

Recipients will be selected by the Board of The Crusader Praise Scott Scholarship Fund, Incorporated. The committee will evaluate eligible students' profiles, academic record, financial need, letters of recommendation, biographical statement and career goals, leadership qualities, extracurricular activities and accomplishments, employment status, and the professional quality of the application. All applications should be thoroughly prepared and neat in appearance. The application must be typed. Applicants may fill out the initial application in draft form and finalize the application using word processing software or typewritten. No handwritten application will be processed. One or more students will receive the scholarship. Scholarships should be distributed during the first semester of each academic year to the academic institution to which the student has been accepted. In the event the student recipient(s) is/are unable to attend the college, university, or training in the Fall of 2020, the award will be returned to the scholarship fund.

APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS:

Qualified applicants must submit the following documents in one package:

1. The completed application form, using word-processed or typed text;
2. A current official High School transcript of grades and SAT/ACT scores;
3. A minimum of (3) letters of recommendation, 1 from either a pastor, coach, teacher, counselor, etc.; and 2 other responsible adults, (non-relative);
4. Essay: What Event Has Had A Significant Impact On Your Life
5. Family income \$100,000.00 or less. Proof of income REQUIRED - i.e., W-2
6. Inclusion of a recent photograph and a signed release form giving the Scholarship Committee permission to use the photograph.

Applications **MUST BE** received by stated deadline. Supporting documents such as 'transcripts and letters of recommendation can be submitted later. Student is responsible for follow-up to ensure that the documents have been sent and received.
