Great Expectations Durham Out of OHIP Care

For deliveries and prenatal care outside of OHIP, fee is \$4000 to your main physician who cares for you in office. This fee will cover:

- 1. Physician fees in office for any physician in our Family Physician group.
- 2. Physician fees at the Birthing Suite/Hospital for pregnancy complications/ assessments outside of labour and delivery.
- 3. Physician fee for the Family Physicians involved in your delivery.

The following are NOT covered by this fee.

- 1. Obstetricians who see you during your pregnancy if you require a high-risk consult, whether in office or at the hospital.
- 2. Anesthesiologists who see you in labour if you request an epidural, or for operative care if you require a cesarean section
- 3. Obstetrician who may attend your delivery if you are deemed high-risk at the time of delivery, or if you require operative delivery/cesarean section.
- 4. Geneticist or Pediatrician if needing a high-risk consult during your pregnancy due to infant concerns.
- 5. If your baby is not going to receive OHIP, you will have to pay for the physicians involved with their care (Family Physicians or Pediatricians)
- 6. You will also have to pay for ultrasounds, bloodwork, and hospital/room fees. These organizations will bill you separately.

The physicians involved will set their own rate if they see you. You are expected to pay these physicians in the event that you need them. It is prudent to have an additional \$5000 available in cash at the time of the delivery (in addition to the \$4000 that you pay upfront) in order to insure all the physicians in your case will be paid to provide you care.
