Introduction

This report provides a small glimpse on the little progress that the Orphanage has gone through.

Dormitory construction

The dormitory is finished. Plastering, flooring and ceiling are done. Glasses and doors are bought and being planed and cut for fixing. The orphanage is excited in expectant for ZOA visits this year. ZOA is expected to paint the dormitory in July. The paints and all requirements are bought and are now on site. The machine by the side of the paint is a loan mower that will help a lot in keeping the grass low at orphanage.

Most encouraging, the older children have made their own beds which they will have to take care of. There has been a delay in stocking the fish pond because the supplier of fingerings has delayed to go buy the fingerings. The DAPP has promised they would help us buy fingerings in Mansa, about 750km away when they buy for their clients in two weeks time.
