

Physical well-being and fine and gross motor development occurs through movement and coordination games and activities. Children participate in outdoor free play on our playground (weather permitting) or

indoor play in the Fellowship Hall. To promote the development of fine motor skills, we provide many opportunities each day for children to use a wide range of manipulatives and visual arts.

Social and emotional development occurs through Individual and group social situations that include story time, sharing, small group play, one-on-one meaningful work with classroom teachers, and cooperative play with classmates. These activities help children practice skills such as taking turns, learning to be a good friend, and expressing feelings in a healthy way. Art and music appreciation through exposure and a creative process approach: children are introduced to different visual art media, provided opportunities to create and express themselves (even if getting messy is part of the process!), and encouraged to display their projects. In a print-rich environment, children participate in making up stories, rhyming and other kinds of word play, and games and activities that require listening to and following directions.

Spiritual development occurs through creating an atmosphere of love and acceptance of each child as a unique individual created by God. 

School Philosophy: Tauxemont Cooperative Preschool provides a play-based curriculum in a nature-focused environment. Our curriculum is a blend of different philosophies – Montessori, Reggio, and HighScope. Lessons follow the seasons. In the Fall, children learn about the weather changing and about the leaves turning colors and falling from trees. In the Winter, lessons center on ice, snow, and hibernation. In the Spring, children learn about flowers, grow plants, see butterflies emerge from cocoons, and watch chicks hatch from eggs. Lessons are reiterated through different means (story, art projects) and revisited to help concepts sink in. There is also a focus on open play. This includes opportunities for the children to choose what they would like to do and explore.

We believe preschool should allow children to:

- Discover that school is a happy place, that learning is fun and rewarding, and that teachers are understanding and stimulating human beings.
- Learn how to work and play successfully with other children.
- Learn to develop their own skills, talents, and interests, and to expand each of these to the fullest extent.
- Develop a sense of personal worth and an understanding of the needs and rights of others.
- Develop a sense of excitement and interest in the world in which we live and an eagerness to learn more.

How we foster child development:

- Provide a wide variety of activities geared to the proper age and skill level of the children.
- Emphasize personal standards and pride of achievement and encourage the child to recognize that the process is as important as the product.

- Encourage arts in addition to crafts, and dramatic and creative play in addition to organized games and activities.
- Consider individual needs and different rates of development in children along with the aims of group activity and socialization.
- Recognize that the most desirable discipline is self-discipline, and that encouragement and consistent standards are more effective than punishment in the development of self-discipline.
- Offer a developmentally appropriate program with little use of formal devices, drills, and competitive learning.

Special Needs: Tauxemont does not discriminate in its enrollment; however, there are no specific services offered at our school for children with special needs.

Other Information: Our classes are specifically arranged in half-years and structured so children may become familiar with new children each year. Age determinations are based on Sept 30th of the new school year.

Our director has over 25 years' experience and our assistant director has over 20. They both teach throughout the age groups. Our staff completes ongoing education as part of our National Association for the Education of Young Children certification. We are one of only three schools in Northern VA with this accreditation.

The Tauxemont learning experience encourages parents to participate with their children during this major step away from home. The interaction between parent, child and teacher is something quite rare and special.

The cooperative experience includes three key parent responsibilities – work in the classroom, an annual job, and Saturday Work Sessions. Anyone can help work in the classroom – mom, dad, grandparent, caregiver: they just need a background check and TB test. The annual job is based on a survey of skills and interests and what works for your family. Saturday Work Sessions (2 per year) help keep tuition costs low and allow families to contribute to the maintenance and upkeep of the school. Some unexpected benefits of the cooperative experience are a feeling of close community, meeting families going through similar stages in life with young children, and friendly, collaborative gatherings that are fun and social because we get to know one another as we work together.


