At these meetings we will give estimated construction and engineering fees to determine the estimated amount to be assess per parcel.

#### Road Report

He is suggesting that we don't grade the roads immediately after new gravel has been laid, let it be, let it get packed down, work towards building the crown and reclaiming the gravel from the ditches. Packing after grading is also becoming a more common practice.
