## *From the Pastor's Desk*

A message from Pope Francis

Dear brothers and sisters,

How many times have we been told otherwise! You have to be something in life, to be someone ... You have to make a name for yourself ... This is where loneliness and unhappiness come from: if I have to be "someone", I compete with others and live in obsessive concern for my ego. If I don't accept being poor, I hate everything that reminds me of my fragility. Because this fragility prevents me from becoming an important person, a rich not only of money, but of fame, of everything.

Everyone, in front of himself, knows well that, however hard he tries, he is always radically incomplete and vulnerable. There is no trick that covers this vulnerability. Each of us is vulnerable inside. Must see where. But how bad you live if you refuse your limits! You live badly. The limit is not digested, it is there. Proud people don't ask for help, they can't ask for help, they don't ask for help because they have to prove themselves self-sufficient. And how many of them need help, but pride prevents asking for help. And how difficult it is to admit a mistake and ask for forgiveness! When I give some advice to the newlyweds, who tell me how to carry out their marriage well, I say to them: "There are three magic words: leave, thank you, sorry". These are words that come from poverty of spirit. It is not necessary to be intrusive, but to ask permission: "Does it seem good to do this?", So there is dialogue in the family, the bride and groom are in dialogue. "You did this for me, thank you I needed it." Then you always make mistakes, you slip: "Excuse me". And usually, couples, new marriages, those who are here and many, tell me: "The third is the most difficult", apologize, ask for forgiveness. Because the proud can't do it. He cannot apologize: he is always right. It is not poor in spirit. Instead the Lord never tires of forgiving; unfortunately it is we who tire of asking for forgiveness (see Angelus, 17 March 2013). The tiredness of asking for forgiveness: this is a bad disease!

Why is it difficult to ask for forgiveness? Because it humiliates our hypocrite image. Still, living trying to hide one's shortcomings is tiring and distressing. Jesus Christ tells us: being poor is an opportunity for grace; and shows us the way out of this effort. We are given the right to be poor in spirit, because this is the way of the Kingdom of God.

Un mensaje del Papa Francisco

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

¡Cuántas veces nos han dicho lo contrario! Tienes que ser algo en la vida, ser alguien ... Tienes que hacerte un nombre ... Aquí es de donde viene la soledad y la infelicidad: si tengo que ser "alguien", compito con los demás y vivo en preocupación obsesiva por mi ego. Si no acepto ser pobre, odio todo lo que me recuerda mi fragilidad. Porque esta fragilidad me impide convertirme en una persona importante, rica no solo en dinero, sino en fama, en todo.

Todos, frente a sí mismo, saben bien que, por mucho que lo intente, siempre es radicalmente incompleto y vulnerable. No hay truco que cubra esta vulnerabilidad. Cada uno de nosotros es vulnerable por dentro. Hay que ver dónde. ¡Pero qué mal vives si rechazas tus límites! Vives mal El límite no se digiere, está ahí. Las personas orgullosas no piden ayuda, no pueden pedir ayuda, no piden ayuda porque tienen que demostrar su autosuficiencia. Y cuántos de ellos necesitan ayuda, pero el orgullo impide pedir ayuda. ¡Y qué difícil es admitir un error y pedir perdón! Cuando les doy un consejo a los recién casados, que me dicen cómo llevar a cabo bien su matrimonio, les digo: "Hay tres palabras mágicas: vete, gracias, lo siento". Estas son palabras que provienen de la pobreza de espíritu. No es necesario ser intrusivo, sino pedir permiso: "¿Parece bueno hacer esto?", Entonces hay un diálogo en la familia, la novia y el novio están en diálogo. "Hiciste esto por mí, gracias, lo necesitaba". Entonces siempre cometes errores, resbalas: "Disculpe". Y por lo general, las parejas, los nuevos matrimonios, los que están aquí y muchos, me dicen: "El tercero es el más difícil", se disculpan, piden perdón. Porque los orgullosos no pueden hacerlo. No puede disculparse: siempre tiene razón. No es pobre en espíritu. En cambio, el Señor nunca se cansa de perdonar; lamentablemente somos nosotros los que nos cansamos de pedir perdón (ver Ángelus, 17 de marzo de 2013). El cansancio de pedir perdón: iesta es una mala enfermedad!

¿Por qué es difícil pedir perdón? Porque humilla nuestra imagen hipócrita. Aún así, vivir tratando de ocultar las deficiencias es agotador y angustiante. Jesucristo nos dice: ser pobre es una oportunidad para la gracia; y nos muestra la salida de este esfuerzo. Se nos da el derecho a ser pobres en espíritu, porque este es el camino del Reino de Dios.

Mensagem do Papa Francisco

Queridos irmãos e irmãs,

Quantas vezes nos disseram o contrário! Você tem que ser algo na vida, ser alguém ... Você tem que fazer um nome para si mesmo ... É aqui que a solidão e a infelicidade vêm: se eu tiver que ser "alguém", eu competir com os outros e viver em preocupação obsessiva pelo meu ego. Se não aceito ser pobre, odeio tudo o que me lembra minha fragilidade. Porque essa fragilidade me impede de me tornar uma pessoa importante, rica não apenas em dinheiro, mas em fama, em tudo.

Todo mundo, à sua frente, sabe bem que, por mais que tente, ele é sempre radicalmente incompleto e vulnerável. Não há truques que cubram essa vulnerabilidade. Cada um de nós é vulnerável por dentro. Deve ver onde. Mas quão ruim você vive se recusar seus limites! Você vive mal. O limite não é digerido, está lá. Pessoas orgulhosas não pedem ajuda, não podem pedir ajuda, não pedem ajuda porque precisam provar que são auto-suficientes. E quantos deles precisam de ajuda, mas o orgulho impede de pedir ajuda. E quão difícil é admitir um erro e pedir perdão! Quando dou alguns conselhos aos noivos, que me dizem como realizar bem o casamento, digo-lhes: "Há três palavras mágicas: saia, obrigado, desculpe". Estas são palavras que vêm da pobreza de espírito. Não é necessário ser intrusivo, mas pedir permissão: "Parece bom fazer isso?", Para que haja diálogo na família, a noiva e o noivo estejam em diálogo. "Você fez isso por mim, obrigado por precisar." Então você sempre comete erros, escorrega: "Com licença". E geralmente, casais, novos casamentos, aqueles que estão aqui e muitos, me dizem: "O terceiro é o mais difícil", pede desculpas, pede perdão. Porque o orgulhoso não pode fazer isso. Ele não pode se desculpar: ele está sempre certo. Não é pobre em espírito. Em vez disso, o Senhor nunca se cansa de perdoar; infelizmente somos nós que nos cansamos de pedir perdão (ver Angelus, 17 de março de 2013). O cansaço de pedir perdão: esta é uma doença ruim!

Por que é difícil pedir perdão? Porque humilha nossa imagem hipócrita. Ainda assim, viver tentando esconder as deficiências é cansativo e angustiante. Jesus Cristo nos diz: ser pobre é uma oportunidade para a graça; e nos mostra a saída desse esforço. Temos o direito de ser pobres de espírito, porque este é o caminho do Reino de Deus.
