
21st. SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Gospel – [Luke 13:22-30](#): “And people will come from the east and the west and from the north and the south and will recline at table in the kingdom of God.”



QUEENSHIP OF MARY


August 22

This feast day celebrates the queenship of Mary, our Blessed Mother. As the mother of Jesus Christ, the Lord of all creation, Mary shares in his royal heritage. She is the Queen Mother.

The queenship of Mary foreshadows the glory in heaven which awaits all of us who recognize her son as ruler of the universe.

*Jesus is King throughout all eternity by nature and by right of conquest: through Him, with Him, and subordinate to Him, **Mary is Queen by grace, by divine relationship**, by right of conquest, and by singular choice [of the Father]. St. Bartholomew is the patron saint of bookbinders, butchers, cobblers, leather workers, nervous diseases, and neurological diseases.

Bartholomew is widely thought to be the person identified as Nathaniel in the Gospel of John. After the resurrection of Jesus, he is one of the apostles who saw our risen Lord at the Sea of Galilee. He went on to evangelize in Asia Minor and was martyred.
