Publius, the Greek sage, put his finger on another technique we tend to forget when he admitted: I have often regretted my speech, never my silence.


In the New Year let's think about all that God gives us including choice of how we glorify Him and live our lives with the gift of listening.

Or with a stick between two Swans...


