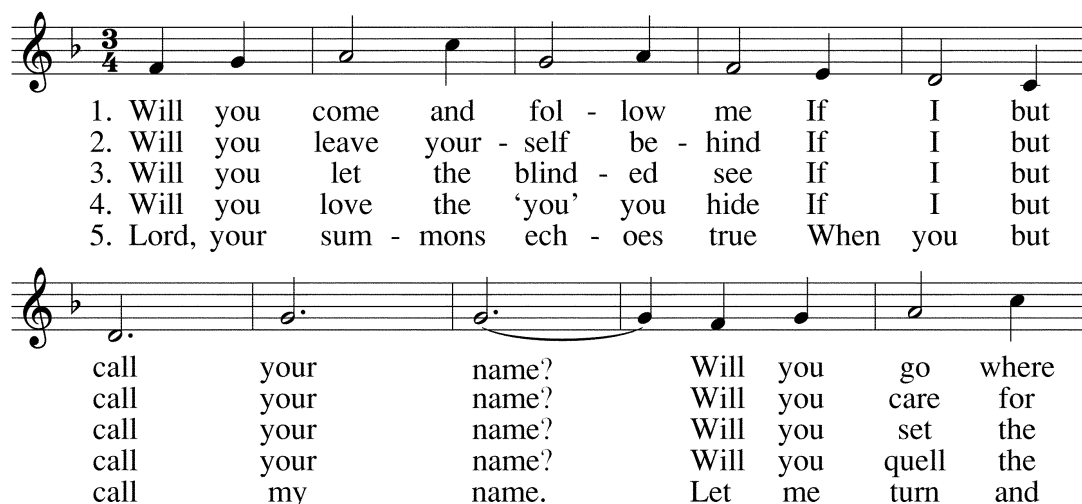
A READING FROM THE HOLY GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MARK 10:46-52




