#### **Historic Clippings**

METHOD OF PRESERVING BEEF. To House-Keepers .- Sort your Beef, let it be coid, but not frozer. To 200 wt. use half a bushel of salt, half a pound of salt petre, and two quarts of molasses. Dissolve your salt petre in water, and add the molasses, then pack down your beef tight, put salt in your barrel, and between each layer, and let a suitable pro. portion of salt-petre and molasses be put on each layer, till all is put together, reserving four or five quarts of salt to make a brine sufficient to cover the beef, which must be added in 4 or 5 days, and your beef will be good through the year. When you salt beef again use the same process-10. 11 or 12 quarts of salt will be enough: but keep your old brine, and in 4 or 5 days add it without boiling, as that will injure it very much. I have tried this method 3 years, and the beef has been sweet and good.
