
With all the unrest in the world,

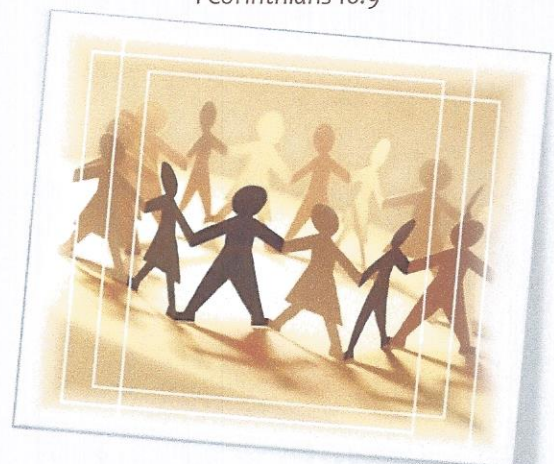

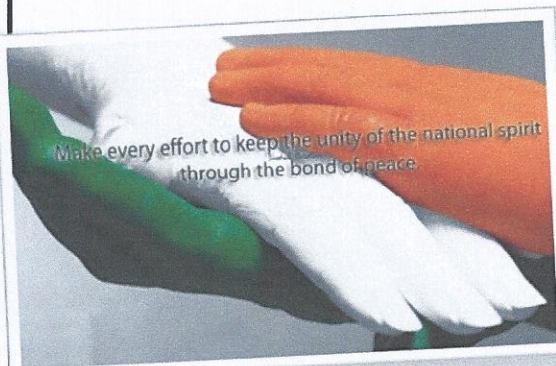
