With Carter being a junior and Hannah in college it is only a matter of time before they both will be out of the house and there are many days when Melinda and I are passing each other as she is coming home and I am heading out to a meeting or church related event. Camping is a way for all of us to be together and there is no agenda. Camp fires, good food, and just being together is a great way to refresh my spirit.

Second is I plan to just attend church and not have to plan or participate in a service. Outside of chapel when I was attending seminary it has been a long time since I just "attended" a worship service. I also plan to take notes and get ideas to bring back for our own churches.

Third is to work around our acreage. There is a long list of things to get done but by getting two or three of those things done it relieves stress as I check that off my list instead of being at the forefront of my mind as I am trying to focus on my priorities as the pastor.

Thank you to those who are covering and filling the pulpit while I am away and thank you to the SPRC for approving this leave. I have full confidence that Asbury and Northwood will be in good hands while I am away and that allows me the opportunity to enjoy my leave. I couldn't have asked for two better churches or the wonderful people who have been such a blessing and support to me these last seven years. I'll join you for Hamballs and chili in November.

#### "One Hundred Fifty UMC Bishops call for rejecting 'idolatry of guns'

United Methodists will need to both pray and act to end the scourge of gun violence, says a letter the Council of Bishops released Sept. 1 to the wider church.

"As people of prayer, we followers of Jesus are called to be 'counter-cultural change makers,'" **the letter says**. "To that end, we must reject the idolatry of guns and the distorted attachments to our right to own guns without safeguards for the communities of the world." United Methodists — **long committed to transforming the world to be more like Christ's** 

<u>example</u> — have a role to play in addressing the crisis, the bishops said. Bishop Julius C. Trimble, former Bishop of the Iowa Conference and who now leads the Indiana Conference, proposed the letter on behalf of the bishops' Justice and Reconciliation Leadership Team. Trimble put it this way: "If there are evidence-based solutions that can lessen the number of deaths due to firearms, why would we not pursue them?" See Bishop's letter at


